ROSETTES

Will be awarded as follows:

All Classes - Individuals to 6th place.

Classes 3, 4, 5 & 8 - Teams to 4th place.

Classes 1 & 2 - Rosettes will also be awarded to all those who complete the course and are not in the first 6 placings (i.e. not eliminated)

NB. The organisers reserve the right to increase/decrease the number of rosettes awarded in ratio to the entries per class and will be announced at the beginning of the class.

A trophy will be presented to the highest placed NWPC Member in all classes.

The Organisers wish to acknowledge the help given by all members of the NWPC, parents and friends in running this show. Helpers are all volunteers so please be respectful to them!

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All classes are open to non-members of the Pony Club. **Non-PC members must be covered by their own insurance.**
2. Classes will be judged under **Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2022** and **The Barrier Spring Festival 2023 rules.**
3. **Judges decision is final.**
4. **Teams** of four members with best three scores to count, which must be declared before the start of the class.
5. **Times & running orders** will be posted on <http://branches.pcuk.org/northwarwickshire/> for each class.
6. **The organisers reserve the right to change classes to two phase if necessary.**
7. **Single phase** – all competitors jump both phases whether they are clear in the first phase or not. Phase 2 will be up to 5cm higher than phase 1.
Two phase – only competitors clear in the 1st phase continue to the 2nd phase against the clock.
8. **Hard hats** to the current Pony Club standard **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted.
9. Any objections must be handed to the Secretary in writing with a deposit of £10 within half an hour of the incident. If the objection is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited.
10. **Health and Safety** The organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the organisers and all officials and stewards.
11. **Legal Liability** Save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other persons or property whatsoever. Entries are accepted on this basis.
12. ***Team competitions** will only run if there are 3 or more pre-entered teams.
