PLEASE NOTE:

Valid Equine Influenza vaccinations are now required for all the above competitions.

Equine Passports: Must accompany the horse to all events
Must be available for inspection
Must be produced on request

Equine Influenza: Must have current equine influenza vaccination
Minimum of two valid injections required

Concussion / Head Injury / Any medical Suspension (Regardless of which sport)

If a member suffers a head injury, suspected concussion or a medical suspension regardless of the circumstances or sport within 21 days of any rally / training / competition, please notify Amelia so she can check compliance with the rules.

Spurs

Spur cards are no longer required, however, any misuse will be reported.

ELIGIBILITY

**Please read the following in full and contact Ros immediately with any questions.
ALL LEVELS [except where stated]**

Rider:

- 1 Membership renewed by 28th February 2018 (ER33.6)
Or
New member by 31st March 2018 (ER33.6)
Please note: Members who have transferred from another Branch within the past 14 months should check with Amelia or Alison that they are eligible to compete in Area competitions that are qualifiers for the Championships. (ER33.7)

EXCEPT: Regional Champs: Riders must be fully paid up members of the OBHPC but with no restrictions with time of joining. (ER33.6)
- 2 Be an active member of the OBHPC. (ER33.5)
- 3 Attended a minimum of x3 working rallies since 1st July 2017 with the OBHPC (or previous PC), excluding team practices and coaching. Rallies must be advertised at least 7 days prior to the date of the rally. The District Commissioner has discretion in the case of those who are working or in further education. (ER33.5)

Horse (or Pony)

- 1 All horses graded BE Advanced (Grade1) or EI Advanced which have completed an AI / A level during the current year are ineligible at all levels. (ER33.1)
- 2 Must be 5 years of age or over and there is no height limit. (ER33..2)
- 3 Can only compete once, **EXCEPT** at Regional level. (ER33.2a – amended)
- 4 Stallions may only be ridden by Members if written permission is obtained from the DC and they must wear identifying discs on their bridles in the interest of safety. (ER33.3)
- 5 Must have genuinely participated in a minimum of x3 working rallies since 1st July 2017. One of which **MUST** be in 2018, excluding team practices and coaching. Rallies must be advertised at least 7 days prior to the date of the rally. The District Commissioner has discretion in the case of those who are working or in further education. (DR33.4)

OBHPC Qualification Requirements:

- 1 Horse and rider combination to have been seen by Ros Hayward, Eventing manager, in the current year in order to be added to the long-list.
- 2 Combinations should demonstrate their ability at the required level in competitions and/or at relevant rallies before 5th June when the final squad will be selected.
- 3 The final squad are strongly encouraged to attend the squad training sessions, at which point Teams and Individuals will be finalized.
- 4 No rider may ride at Regionals if previously ridden in any discipline at PC90 / Novice or above or plan to in 2018.

LEVEL SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY

Please note the following are in ADDITION to the above.

PC110:

No further restrictions.

PC100:

Horse & rider combination:

- 1 Not to have completed a PC110 Area Eventing competition or above in the current or previous years. (ER33PC100Ai)
- 2 Not to have completed a BE (or EI) Intermediate or above (ER33PC100Aii)
- 3 Not to have achieved more than 3 clear cross country rounds at BE (or EI) Novice, (or Pony Trials, Open Novice.) (ER33PC100Aii)

PC90:

Rider:

- 1 Not to have completed a PC110 Area Level or above competition or BE (or EI) Novice, in Eventing in the current year or have done so in previous years. (ER33PC90Ai)

Horse & rider combination:

- 1 Not to have completed a BE (or EI) Novice (or Pony Trial) or above. (ER33PC90Bi)
- 2 Not to have achieved more than three clear cross county rounds at BE (EI) 100. (ER33PC90Bii)
- 3 Not to have completed an PC100 Area or above competition in Eventing in the current year or have done so previously. (ER33PC90Biii)

Open PC90:

No further restrictions.

Regional:

Rider:

- 1 Not to have competed at PC90 level or above in any Eventing Competition. (ER33RCAi).
PLEASE NOTE: OBHPC requirements above which exceed this rule.

Horse & rider combination:

- 1 Not to have completed at PC90 or above Eventing at Area or Championship level or BE90 (or EI) competition (ER33RCBi)
PLEASE NOTE: OBHPC requirements above which exceed this rule.

IT IS THE PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT BOTH RIDER AND HORSE ARE ELIGIBLE AND QUALIFIED FOR SELECTION, AND REMAIN SO THROUGH TO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.
