



OBHPC Brightwalton Camp, 2019
Monday 29th July – Wednesday 31st July

General Information

Venue

We are very pleased to confirm that, once again, we can hold camp at Brightwalton Stud. The excellent facilities include outdoor arenas, cross country course, show jumping paddock, grass dressage arena and several smaller, enclosed paddocks. The full address is Brightwalton Stud, Brightwalton, Newbury, Berks RG20 7BZ.

Cost

The cost for the Three-day camp has remained at £120, which offers excellent value for money. The payment can be split into £80 deposit on booking and the balance of £40 no later than 1st June. Or in one payment on booking. A full refund will be due for all cancellations made on or before the 1st of June. Cancellations made after that date will be refunded in full if your space can be filled. Last minute cancellations and those that cannot be filled, will be subject to a deduction of all costs incurred.

Activities

Activities will be tailored to suit all abilities, with emphasis on safety, good instruction, fun and gaining confidence. Please remember that this is not an intensive training week, it is an opportunity for the children to try new activities in a safe environment. The instructors will encourage, but not force, any child to participate in all activities.

If there are any equestrian activities you do not wish your child or pony to participate in, (e.g. mounted games, riding bareback/ without stirrups etc), you must highlight it on the booking form. If the instructor wishes to schedule this activity we will try to organise for your child to be moved to a different ride, whilst this activity is happening. If this is not possible, we will assure your child is excluded from the activity. Please note that all instructors have a wealth of experience, but if you wish for your child/pony to be excluded we will respect that.

Children

This camp is intended for Pony Club members aged between 5 and 10 years. Preference will be given to children within this age bracket and places will be filled on a first come first served basis.

There will be an instructor and coach or helper allocated for each ride. **If your child needs 1 on 1 assistance when riding, please note you are responsible for organising this support.**

If possible, your child and pony should have attended a minimum of 3 rallies in the 12-month period prior to camp. The Big Rally at Elmwood will be on 28th May this year and is a great chance for the instructors to see your child ride.

There will be several other Mini rallies planned April-June Attending rallies prior to camp allows the instructors the opportunity to assess your child and pony and help us to ensure that they are placed in the correct ride. Any pony deemed not suitable for camp, by an instructor, will be asked to leave.

Ponies

Vaccinations – Due to recent Equine flu cases, regulations have been amended. Brightwalton have asked us to ensure ALL ponies must be vaccinated against Equine Flu, within 6 months of camp. Any pony arriving at camp, whose vaccinations are not up to date, will be sent home on Day 1. Please contact us if you are unsure.

Please include a photocopy of your vaccination certificate including the name/identification page and full details of the primary course and vaccination history, with your booking form. This is so we can check this in advance.

Please do not bring very young or inexperienced ponies to camp – ponies under 5 will need special permission. Any pony deemed not suitable for camp, by an instructor, will be asked to leave. Ponies that kick will need to wear a red ribbon or tape.

Ponies will be ridden twice a day for three days so will need to have been ridden regularly before camp.

There is very limited space for ponies to stay at camp and we don't know exact number of spaces until the week before. Priority is given to those travelling furthest, BUT please highlight on the form if you would like to go on the list for either a stable or field space.

Parents

Parents are more than welcome to stay at Camp if they wish. Children tend to concentrate better without their parents watching and there will be plenty of helpers should you not wish or be able to stay. However, extra hands are always welcomed to help with juice runs etc.

All children must be checked in and out of the venue. Please give rider names to steward (child) on arrival and departure.

Trailers can be left during the day, parked in the designated field, with the brake engaged – ponies will be tied around the perimeter of the field in rides and a tack tent will be available for each ride.

On the first morning please arrive at Brightwalton with your child at 9.15am, you will then be required to have passports and hat/back protectors checked. Please also check the information boards to find your designated ride and instructor.

Tack and equipment and packed lunch should then be stored in the rides tents provided. Please leave your pony with a full hay net and water for the day. Rides will aim to be ready and off for 10am daily and your child and pony will be ready to collect at 4pm every day.

On the last day there will be a display for all parents at 2pm. After this all parents will be required to help clear up prior to prize giving.

Booking

Please return your completed Booking form by post to: Danni O'Neill, The Old Granary, Fawley, Wantage, Oxon OX12 9NJ ASAP. Bookings will not be held without a completed form, and places are allocated on a first come first served basis. All applications must be received by 1st June 2019.

Applications can only be accepted from fully paid up members of the Pony Club. PLEASE NOTE there is NO refund policy, unless a suitable replacement can be found for your child.
