Dear Members and Parents,

I am delighted to be organising the OBHPC Senior Camp again for 2019. I look forward to your application to come to camp and I would like to give you a bit of an outline as to the things we are offering this year.

Camp is held at Hartpury College offering the very best facilities for both horse and rider. We have exclusive use of indoor and outdoor arenas, a XC field, a full set of show jumps, and permanent boxes with secure tack rooms. Accommodation is within the college halls of residence. Meals are in the college canteen.

Evening entertainments will include a disco, demonstrations, games and off campus activities such as bowling, laser tag or swimming.

The mornings and first full afternoon at camp will be spent with your instructor riding and doing stable management, however for the other afternoons the instructors will be offering a wide range of activities so that you can tailor camp to your horse's needs and your interests. This will enable you to specialise with dressage tutorials, jumping clinics, gridwork, cross country, test preparation, young horse education and rider fitness, as well as some less horse-oriented activities, and to mix and match activities every day. Our intention is that Senior Camp should be equally fun and fulfilling for every member over 12, regardless of their (or their horse's) interests and experience. You do not need to have ambitions to jump around Badminton to enjoy camp!

There will be an opportunity to take D+ or C Test at Camp. For members aiming for C+, B, B+ or AH Test we can incorporate intensive test preparation at camp.

Arrival will be late afternoon/early evening (exact time TBC) on Sunday 28th July, with departure at 2pm on Friday 2nd August. On the departure day children will have a morning of lessons as normal, which parents will be welcome to watch, followed by a picnic lunch with parents.

Please note, all horses will need to be correctly vaccinated for flu and must have had a booster in the 6 months before camp, and not within 7 days of camp starting. Please check now while there is still time to re-start the course if needed.

Please supply your own hard food and hay.

The cost does not include extra bedding. If you need additional bedding please provide your own or Hartpury can supply pre-ordered Cushionbed @ £8.00 per bale. Please add your requirements to your application form.

If you wish your horse to live on straw or another type of bedding you must provide this yourself. Please contact us to arrange.

We will endeavour to guarantee space for anyone applying by 5th June 2019

Final deadline for applications is 1st July 2019; £50.00 extra after this date, subject to space.

Further information about the horse and rider will be requested by email at a later date. At this stage we just ask for you to return your application so we can book suitable instructors at the earliest opportunity.

For this application to be considered you must:

* Be a fully paid up member of the OBHPC.

* If possible all members to have attended 3 rallies on the horse/pony they intend to bring to camp. This enables us to ensure they are in the most appropriate group.

Please send your application form with all sections filled in, including:

- **Signed Declaration of Understanding**
- **Cheque for £410 plus £8 per bale for any additional bedding required, payable to OBHPC, or deposit of £100 and post dated cheques for 1st May and 1st June for the remainder.**

Applications received after 1st July will be charged an extra £50.00 and will only be accepted if space allows.

Cancellations before 5th June will be refunded in full. After 5th June we will refund in full less any costs incurred on your behalf eg. If your space can be filled you will get 100% refund. If you cancel at the last minute we would hope to refund stabling, accommodation and food costs.

FLU VACCINATIONS 2019

PLEASE CHECK VACCINATIONS TODAY while there is still time to re-start vaccinations if needed.

Your 2nd vaccination date must fall between 21 and 92 days of the 1st vaccination, with the 3rd vaccination between 150 and 215 days of the 2nd vaccination.

The horse must have had a booster in the 6 months before camp, and not within 7 days of camp starting.

If your passport has been checked (eg at Awards Night) and issued with a PC sticker, it indicates that it was fully up to date at that point.

Remember to bring your passport when you drop your horse off at Camp as Hartpury WILL spot check!

DECLARATION OF UNDERSTANDING AND UNDERTAKING

Declaration of understanding and undertaking on their child attending the OBHPC Camp at Hartpury.

- I understand that I will be responsible for ensuring the camp organisers are made fully aware of any medical or personal problems that may affect my child in any way.
- I will ensure the horse/pony is fit for the work required, well shod, with well fitting tack, in good repair and has an up to date flu certificate (correctly administered vaccinations including a booster in the 6 months before camp) that I WILL BRING TO HARTPURY.
- I will ensure that my child's hat and back protector conform to the current Pony Club standards.
- My child will not bring alcohol or cigarettes to camp, should either be found in my child's possession, regardless of whether he or she brought them to camp, I agree to collect both the child and the horse immediately.
- I understand that there is a strict mobile phone policy at Camp and the use of mobile phones and/or access to certain websites or social media platforms may be restricted.
- In the event of my child requiring emergency medical or dental treatment whilst taking part in Pony Club Camp, and an Officer or other responsible adult being unable to contact either myself or other person with a parental responsibility for my daughter/son, I hereby authorise the District Commissioner or other Officer of the Pony Club to obtain such medical or dental treatment for my child as they, in their absolute discretion, think necessary after consultation with a medical or dental practitioner. This authority extends to all medical and dental treatment including the giving of an anaesthetic where necessary.
