PLEASE NOTE:

Valid Equine Influenza vaccinations are now required for all the above competitions.

Equine Passports:Must accompany the horse to all events

Must be available for inspection

Must be produced on request

Equine Influenza:Must have current equine influenza vaccination

Minimum of two valid injections required

Concussion / Head Injury / Any medical Suspension (Regardless of which sport)

If a member suffers a head injury, suspected concussion or a medical suspension regardless of the circumstances or sport within 21 days of any rally / training / competition, please notify Phoebe / Claire so she can check compliance with the rules.

Spurs

Spur cards are no longer required, however, any misuse will be reported.

ELIGIBILITY

Please read the following in full and contact Phoebe / Claire immediately with any questions.

ALL LEVELS [except where stated]

Rider:

1. Membership renewed by 28th February 2019 (SJ29.4)

Or

New member by 31st March 2019 (SJ29.4)

Please note: Members who have transferred from another Branch within the past 14 months should check with Amelia or Alison that they are eligible to compete in Area competitions that are qualifiers for the Championships. (SJ29.6)

EXCEPT:Regional Champs: Riders must be fully paid up members of the OBHPC but with no restrictions with time of joining. (SJ29.6)

2. Be an active member of the OBHPC. (SJ29.5)
3. Attended a minimum of x3 working rallies since 1st July 2018 with the OBHPC (or previous PC), excluding team practices and coaching. Rallies must be advertised at least 7 days prior to the date of the rally. The District Commissioner has discretion in the case of those who are working or in further education. (SJ29.5)

Horse (or Pony):

1. Must be 5 years of age or over and there is no height limit. (SJ29.1)
2. Stallions may only be ridden by Members if written permission is obtained from the DC and they must wear identifying discs on their bridles in the interest of safety. (SJ29.3)
3. Must have genuinely participated in a minimum of x3 working rallies since 1st July 2017. One of which **MUST** be in 2018, excluding team practices and coaching. Rallies must be advertised at least 7 days prior to the date of the rally. The District Commissioner has discretion in the case of those who are working or in further education. (SJ29.4)

Combinations:

1. No combinations can ride at two different levels of the same sport but can ride at different levels in different sports subject to all other eligibility criteria. (SJ29.2)

OBHPC Qualification Requirements:

1. Horse and rider combination to have been seen by Phoebe / Claire, Show Jumping managers, in the current year in order to be added to the long-list.

2. Combinations should demonstrate their ability at the required level in competitions and/or at relevant rallies before 3rd June when the final squad will be selected.
3. The final squad are strongly encouraged to attend the squad training sessions, at which point Teams and Individuals will be finalized.

LEVEL SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY

Please note the following are in ADDITION to the above.

Please note: It is the members responsibility to check the rules for BS / SJI classes carefully for the maximum height of ANY fences so as not to inadvertently become ineligible.

Open:

Horse & rider combination:

1. Not to have achieved a double clear in BS (or SJI) competitions where any of the fences were above 1.30m in the first round. (SJ29.Open.i)

EXCEPT: After Areas & before Championships ONLY

Combinations are permitted to have achieved double clears in BS (or SJI) competitions where any of the fences were above 1.30m in the first round but not above 1.40m. (SJ29OpenChi)

Intermediate:

Horse & rider combination:

1. Not to have completed an Open Area Show Jumping competition or above in previous years. (SJ29.Inter.i.)
2. Not to have achieved one double clear in BS or SJI competitions where any fences were above 1.10m in the first round. (SJ29.Inter.ii)

Except: in BS Senior Newcomers Preliminary or BS Junior Foxhunter Preliminary competitions.

EXCEPT: After Areas & before Championships ONLY

Combinations are permitted to have achieved double clears in BS (or SJI) competitions where any of the fences were above 1.30m in the first round but not above 1.40m. (SJ29IntChi)

Novice:

Rider:

1. Not to have completed an Open Area Level or above competition in Eventing or Show Jumping in the current year or have done so in previous years. (SJ29.Nov.i)

Horse & rider combination:

1. Not to have completed an Open Area level or above in Eventing or Show Jumping in the current year or have done so in previous years. (SJ29.Nov.i)

2. Not to have achieved one double clear in BS or SJI competitions where any fences were above 1.00m in the first round. (SJ29.Nov.iii)

EXCEPT: After Areas & before Championships ONLY

Combinations are permitted to have achieved double clears in BS (or SJI) competitions where any of the fences were above 1m in the first round but not above 1.10m. For clarity: a double clear in a Senior Newcomers preliminary or Junior Foxhunter Preliminary is NOT permitted.). (SJ29NovChi)

Open Novice:

Rider:

1. Open to all members who are not eligible for the Novice. (SJ29.ON.i)
2. Must comply with all other eligibility requirements. (SJ29.ON.iii)

Horse:

1. Open to any horse. (SJ29.ON.ii)
2. Must comply with all other eligibility requirements. (SJ29.ON.iii)

Regional:

Rider:

1. Not to have previously represented their Branch at Novice level or above in any Show Jumping or Eventing Area Competitions. (SJ29.RC.i).

Horse & rider combination:

1. Not to have recorded a double clear at 90cm or above in the first round at BS or SJI competitions. (SJ29RCi)
2. Not to have received a money prize in any BS (or points in any SJI) competition which was 90cm or above in the first round. (SJ29.RC.ii)
3. Not to have previously competed in their Dengie Winter League Area or Dengie Open Area competition. (SJ29.RC.iii)

EXCEPT: After Areas & before Championships ONLY

Combinations are permitted to have achieved double clears and receive prize money in BS (or SJI) competitions at 90cm or above in the first round but not above 1m. (SJ29RCChi)

IT IS THE PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT BOTH RIDER AND HORSE ARE ELIGIBLE AND QUALIFIED FOR SELECTION, AND REMAIN SO THROUGH TO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.
