# Rules and Conditions of Entry

Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules



1. The competition will be run in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Sport Rules 2020.
2. Each District Commissioner is required to certify the eligibility of each horse and rider.
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. Protests and Objections - please see Pony Club Dressage Rule Book 2020 & Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2020
5. Horses/ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor.
6. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
7. No rider may enter more than one class.
8. Please note that no commanders are allowed.
9. Spurs may be worn.
10. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may compete in the Dressage. No horse/pony under the age of 5 may compete in the Show Jumping.
11. Show Jumping Round 1 to be run as Table A (straight round with time allowed). Round 2 as a single phase.
12. Entries dependent on branch membership numbers. For branches of 60 and under, one team will be allowed per class. For branches of 61-100, two teams per class. For branches with over 100 members, 3 teams per class will be allowed.
13. Individuals may be entered

## Entries

1. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
2. In the event of cancellation, £5 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. Refunds done online via Horse Events
3. After the relevant closing date no substitution may be made of horses or riders except in the case of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances which must be certified in writing by the relevant District Commissioner to the secretary. No substitutions can be made after the competition has started.
4. A booking fee will be added to each entry.
5. Entries to be submitted by DC's/branch.

## Rider and Public Safety

1. All hats must have a certified Pony Club tag.
2. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept to the horse box park or collecting rings. They must not be exercised in the car/lorry park, or among spectators. **No lungeing in the lorry park.** Horses/ponies tied to trailers or lorries must not be left unattended.
3. **All dogs should be kept on a short lead at all times. The owners of any loose dogs will be fined £20 per dog with proceeds donated to the Air Ambulance. Please clean up after your dog.**

## Event Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
1. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

## COVID-19

1. Social distancing is to be practiced at all times.
2. Anyone feeling unwell must NOT attend.
3. Parking slots will be marked out in accordance with social distancing regulations. You must park in front of a white post.
4. Each rider may have one supporter which may be a parent/driver/groom. DCs may attend to support their teams.
5. For dressage no trainers or supporters will be allowed in working-in area. Working-in time will be limited to 21 minutes to keep numbers down. You must go in strict time order.
6. For show jumping an exercise arena with no jumps will be provided for a maximum of 12 mins and five horses at a time . The warm-up arena will be stewarded and warm-up time is limited to 10 minutes. Maximum 4 horses at one time. No spectators or grooms are allowed to access the warm-up arena. There will be a steward to do warm up fences.
7. No prize-giving will take place on the day, results will be posted online. Rosettes will given to your DC or posted out to you.
