If you need to cancel your space at any stage we will refund your payment in full less any costs incurred on your behalf eg If your space can be filled you will get 100% refund less a minimal administration charge.

## **FLU VACCINATIONS**

PLEASE CHECK VACCINATIONS TODAY while there is still time to restart vaccinations if needed.

The Minimum Vaccination Requirements for a pony/horse are that it has received:

A Primary Vaccination followed by a Secondary Vaccination given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days after the Primary Vaccination

If sufficient time has elapsed, a booster vaccination given not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the Secondary Vaccination and further booster vaccinations at intervals of not more than a year apart.

If 2nd vaccination date does not fall between 21 and 92 days of the 1st vaccination then the whole vaccination programme must be restarted.

If 3rd vaccination date does not fall between 150 and 215 days of the 2nd vaccination then again the whole vaccination programme must be restarted.

Booster vaccinations must have been given on or before the anniversary of the last vaccination.

**ALL PONIES/HORSES MUST HAVE HAD A BOOSTER IN THE LAST 6 MONTHS AND NOT WITHIN 7 DAYS OF CAMP STARTING.**

In the event of restarting the vaccination programme you must have had the first two vaccinations before the start of camp, the second of which must be at least 7 days beforehand.

All the above requirements must be met otherwise you will not be able to attend camp – as Hartpury is a competition centre we regret that there are no exceptions.

**REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR PASSPORT WHEN YOU COME TO HARTPURY AS THEY WILL SPOT CHECK**

- Members will not bring drugs, cigarettes or alcohol to camp, should any be found in their possession, regardless of whether he or she brought them to camp, I agree to collect both the member and the pony/ horse immediately.
- I understand that there is a strict mobile phone policy at camp and the use of mobile phones and/or posting to websites or social media platforms is strictly prohibited.
- In the event of my child requiring emergency medical or dental treatment whilst taking part in Pony Club Camp, and an Officer or other responsible adult being unable to contact either myself or other person with a parental responsibility for my daughter/son, I hereby authorise the District Commissioner or other Officer of the Pony Club to obtain such medical or dental treatment for my child as they, in their absolute discretion, think necessary after consultation with a medical or dental practitioner. This authority extends to all medical and dental treatment including the giving of an anaesthetic where necessary.
