**Lorries/cars with trailers should park at least 5m apart in the lorry park.**

**Class Times and a running order will be given** – please see the Croome Hunt Branch website ([branches.pcuk.org/croome](http://branches.pcuk.org/croome) – click on Drawn Orders/Competition Times in index on the left hand side on Home page) from Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October (evening) for accepted entries.

# SCHEDULE

**Class One:** 50cm\* (single fences only)

**Class Two:** 60cm\*

**Class Three:** 70cm

**Class Four★:** 80cm – sections A & B

**Class Five★:** 90cm – sections A & B

*\* Classes 1 & 2 are intended for Novice riders/combinations – any rider/combo that has been placed 1<sup>st</sup> more than three times in those class heights or above at any SJ show are asked NOT to enter these classes.*

*Combinations that enter Class One, may only enter Class Two as well.*

*Combinations in Class One may be assisted – any contact between the assistant and the rider or pony will render the combination HC*

All classes are for Teams and Individuals (see Rule 1)

**★Classes Four and Five: Section A** – preliminary round for PC Spring Festival Debut (class 4) or PC Spring Festival PC Challenge (class 5).

£1 PC levy applies to each combination entered in Section A

**Section B** – for those NOT in Section A

**Classes 4A and 5A qualify for the Area Spring Festival competitions.** The numbers qualifying depend on the number of starters in the section. Riders do not have to be members of The Pony Club to qualify for the Area competition but must become a member **before** entering the Area competition.

The class height is the maximum height of fences in the first phase/round; fences may be raised by up to 5cm in the second section. All classes will be run Single Phase.

**Entry Fee:** £15 per combination per class (plus a £1 PC levy for combinations in 4A and 5A)

**NO entries will be accepted without full payment** – all classes must be paid for by BACS (see the Entry form for bank details) – your entry will not be deemed accepted until payment has been received; entries may be emailed to the Entries Secretary and entrants are agreeing to abide by the rules etc as if they have signed a paper form or the form may be posted. Entries made by a Branch/Centre are to be paid with **one** BACS payment please.

**PRE-ENTRY ONLY: Closing date for Entries – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021**

(Entries will close earlier if classes are full and a waiting list will be held).

A current list of entries will be put on the Drawn Orders/Competition Times page on the Croome PC website from 4<sup>th</sup> October and regularly updated – if you have sent your entry and it is not there – please get in contact asap.

**Late Entries:** if you miss the closing date please contact the Entries Secretary for any available spaces.

**ROSETTES:** to at least sixth place for teams and individuals in each class, except as follows –

Classes Four & Six will run with one set of team placings, for each class, (team members may be in either section), and one set of individual placings for each class, covering both sections.

Results for the Spring Qualifier sections will be sent to the PC Office.

**If Covid Restrictions apply - There will be no formal prize giving – the DC or Branch Proprietor or their representative may come and collect rosettes (and any qualifying cards for the Spring Festival) from the Judges Box after each class – if not collected then the Branch/Centre/Individual will be contacted after the show and asked if they would like their rosette(s) and asked to pay a small contribution towards p&p.**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**PASSPORTS:** horses/ponies will not be allowed to compete without their passport with valid flu vaccinations – please scan and email the page showing all vaccinations from the primary course and the first page showing the horse's name to Jane Ogle by 15<sup>th</sup> October for checking. **Passports will be spot checked for compliance. A horse with a non-compliant passport will NOT be allowed to compete and there will be no refund of entry. Please allow time for passport checking.**

**NUMBERS:** rider numbers must be printed out by each competitor – if wearing a number bib please wear front and back. **If the number is to be put on the saddlecloth – please do A5 size and wear both sides. If the number is to be worn on the back of the rider, then please print at least A5 size. Numbers to be printed/written as large as possible in dark ink please. Please do NOT use bridle numbers.**

1. Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 combinations, with the best three scores to count.
2. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day) or the Judges (if no Secretary on the day).
3. **TEAM MANAGERS:** entries will be accepted in order of receipt/full payment. See Drawn Orders/ Times on Croome Hunt Pony Club website for accepted entries ([branches.pcuk.org/croome](http://branches.pcuk.org/croome)). A current entry list will be on the website from 4<sup>th</sup> October – please check to ensure your entry has been received.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, alter the order of the classes, cancel classes and/or limit entries.
5. **Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited.** If you miss the closing date, please email the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.
6. **Closing date for entries – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021.**

Withdrawal refunds will only be given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary by 26<sup>th</sup> October 2021– please scan and email to the Entries Secretary with bank details for a BACS payment (bank, sort code & account number)

7. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded on receipt of an email by 26<sup>th</sup> October 2021 with details for a BACS payment –details required as above (item 6)

***Any refund may be subject to an administration fee.***

8. **TIMES/DRAWN ORDERS WILL BE GIVEN** – please see the Croome Hunt P.C. website ([branches.pcuk.org/croome](http://branches.pcuk.org/croome)) from Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October (evening).

Competitors may be asked to jump before their drawn order time – please be ready.

9. **Competitor numbers MUST always be visible whilst mounted.**

**10. There will be a steward to do the jumps in the jump warm-up. Accompanying adults may watch the collecting and jump arena from the seats in the gallery. Only competitors (and assistants in Class One) and stewards may be in the warm-up arenas.**

11. Each horse/pony may only jump once in each class and in a maximum of three classes. Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Entries Secretary; any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member **must** have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be sent to the Entries Secretary prior to the show day. Stallions must wear stallion discs and ribbons.

All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.

12. Turnout for ALL Pony Club members and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show-jumping 2020.

13. **SPURS:** ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground, by **any** competitor, must comply with Pony Club rules. Misuse of spurs by any competitor will be recorded and reported and may result in disqualification from the competition.

14. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

15. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Judges Box in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the end of that class.

16. **INSURANCE:** please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

17. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena before you jump.

18. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Hartpury University will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property, or other persons.

19. No horses/ponies may be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the field/lorry park. Please park cars as directed (usually in the lower car park) – not by the lorries.

20. **Dogs – must always be kept on a short lead and be under close control . Please clear up after your dog.**

21. **The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2020.**

## DISCLAIMERS

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land , cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Croome Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.
