<p><b>Class 1b – The Pony Club Walk &amp; Trot Dressage Test 2013 (sponsored by Stirrups Equestrian Supplies)</b>  Open to competitors 10 years &amp; over.</p>	£15
<p><b>Class 2a – The Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 (sponsored by Felcourt Cross Country Course)</b>  Riders are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Previously represented their Branch or Centre at Novice level or above in any Dressage or Eventing Area competitions.</li> </ul> <p>Combination of Horse and rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Competed at Prelim level with British Dressage to include My/Team Quest.</li> <li>• Entered Class 3.</li> </ul>	£15
<p><b>Class 2b –The Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 (sponsored by Felbridge Photography)</b>  Open to all competitors not eligible for class 2a.</p>	£15
<p><b>Class 3a – The Pony Club Spring Festival of Dressage Preliminary Qualifier – Novice Dressage Test 2020 (sponsored by Henhaw Arena &amp; Livery)</b>  Riders are NOT eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If they have represented a Branch/Centre at Open area Dressage.</li> <li>• If they have won and BD points at Novice level or above.</li> <li>• If they have competed at more than two Novice MyQuest/Teamquest competitions.</li> <li>• If they have competed at BD Novice Music competitions.</li> </ul>	£17
<p><b>Class 3b – Novice Dressage Test 2020</b>  Non-qualifier – for those not eligible for Section A</p>	£15
<p><b>Class 4 – The Pony Club Spring Festival of Dressage Preliminary Qualifier – Intermediate Test 2013 (sponsored by Cinder Hill Equine Veterinary Clinic)</b>  Combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If they have represented a Branch/Centre at Open Area Dressage.</li> </ul>	£17
<p><b>Class 5 – The Pony Club Spring Festival of Dressage Preliminary Qualifier – Open Dressage Test 2020 (sponsored by Lingfield Equine Vets)</b>  Horses/ponies are NOT eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If they have won more than 10 points at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year (this includes Hors Concours entries).</li> </ul>	£17
<p><b>Branch Team Competition (sponsored by Lingfield Equine Vets)</b>  Teams to consist of 3 or 4 members, with at least one rider in Class 1, 2 and 3 (any section). A fourth rider can be entered in any class. The top three scores will count. Please state test and team name when entering if entering more than one test.</p>	+ £2 per team member

## COVID-19 RULES

These rules are essential to ensure that this competition is able to go ahead safely under current Government restrictions. Anyone failing to abide by these rules will be asked to leave the showground.

1. Government guidelines must be adhered to at all time. SOCIAL DISTANCE and WASH YOUR HANDS. Hand sanitizer will be available.
2. A COVID compliance officer will be on site, please alert them immediately if you have any concerns.
3. Check your temperature at home, and do not attend the show if you have a temperature or feel unwell.
4. Please remember to bring your horse's passport.
5. Make sure that your hat is tagged before the show, as we will not be tagging hats on the day.
6. All vehicles will be checked on arrival against the running order. Only one vehicle per competitor, no additional vehicles will be admitted.
7. Please park at least 5m away from other vehicles. No horses/ponies should be left tied up to the outside of a lorry/trailer.
8. Only one groom/helper per competitor is permitted. NO SPECTATORS.
9. No competitor numbers will be provided. To help us to run smoothly, please keep to your times.
10. Keep at least 2m away from all other people on site at all times.
11. Do not share equipment, clothing, or food.
12. If possible, please avoid using the loos on site and use your own lorry facilities (if possible), or wait until you get home.
13. Masks must be worn inside the Clubhouse, with the exception of children aged 12 and under.
14. Contact details must be given on the entry form and will be kept for 21 days for the Government 'Track and Trace' scheme.
15. Competitors should first warm up in the Bill Kear arena (35 mins ahead of start time) – no more than four competitors at a time. The next two competitors to go will be allowed to use the indoor warm up arena.
16. Competitors should aim to keep at least 3 horse's distance between them at all times, especially in the warm up area.
17. Only one helper will be permitted at the warm up for each competitor.
18. Once a competitor has finished their test they must exit the area immediately and return to the lorry park.
19. Please leave the showground as soon as possible after the completion of your test.
20. There will be no prizegiving. Competitors should leave a large stamped addressed envelope for scoresheets and any rosettes to be sent on.
21. A fully-qualified first-aider will be on site, who will supply their own PPE. If possible, first aid should be administered by a member of the person's own household.

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Dressage Rules 2020.
2. Telephone entries or entries without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
3. All hats to be worn in the competition must be checked as being tagged, hats must conform to the current Pony Club standards and must have a chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. In the interests of safety, the organisers reserve the right to eliminate anyone in breach of this rule.
4. Protest and Objections. Please see rule 47 of the Rule Book.
5. In the event of cancellation £5 of the entry will be retained to defray costs. Please send a S.A.E. in the event of cancellation for the remaining entry to be returned.
6. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept in the box park or collecting rings, they must not be exercised (including lunging) in the car/box park or among spectators.
7. Horses/ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor.
8. Please clear up all hay and droppings from around your box/trailer. Please do not tie haynets to the side of trailers/boxes.
9. No horse/pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
10. It is recommended that all mares in season and known kickers should wear a red ribbon on their tail. Stallions may only compete with a written letter of permission from your DC, and should wear a disc. No horse/pony under 4yrs may compete.
11. Dogs should be left at home if possible, and if not should be kept on a short lead. Please make sure you clear up after your dog.
12. For safety reasons, no jewellery (including "sleepers") may be worn.
13. Refunds for entries will only be given if a doctor's note or vet's certificate is provided.

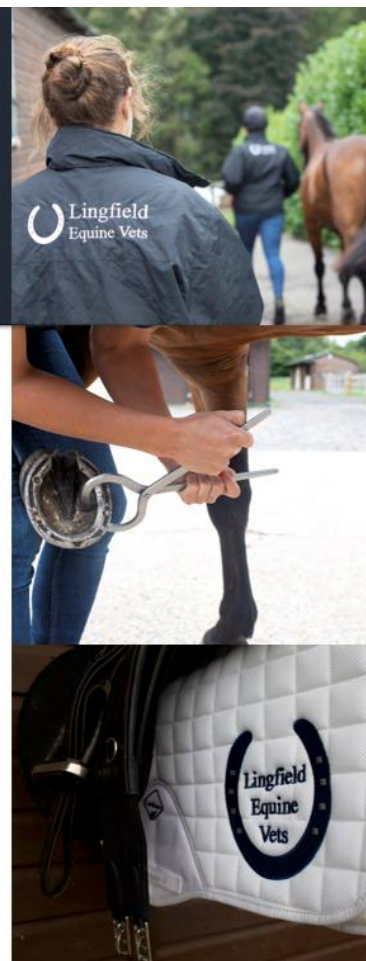

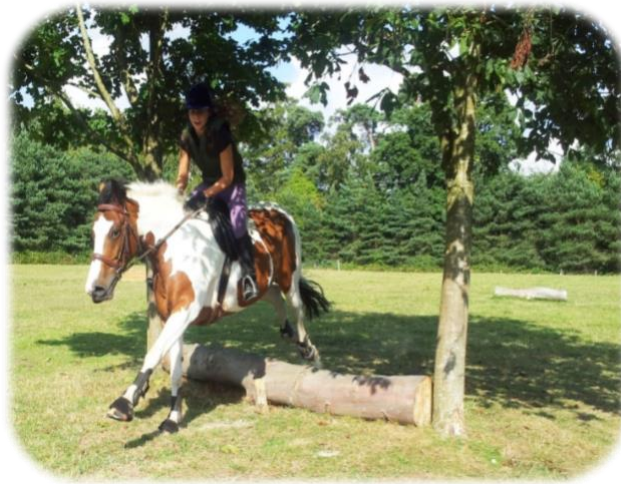
