- 8 Lead rein pony club pony (must be pc member)

The first 4 highest placed Oxenholme members in each class (28J, 28S & 30J, 30S) will qualify for the Todd's finals day, to be held on the 17 August 2025

If a horse and rider combination placed 1-4 have already qualified at a previous Gymkhana then the next placed horse and rider combination will be taken.

Only Oxenholme members can qualify for the finals day but the classes are open to anyone to enter

The Pony Club's purpose is to:- "encourage young people to ride and to learn to enjoy all kinds of sport connected with ponies and riding; to give instruction in riding and horsemastership and to educate Members to look after and take proper care of their animals; to promote the highest ideals of sportsmanship, citizenship and loyalty to create strength of character and self-discipline"

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. **Non-competitive entries** will be accepted by combination of horse & rider wishing to enter a class lower or higher than their proper height/age, but after competing non-competitively, that combination will be non-competitive for the remainder of the day.
- 2. All entries to be paid for at the time of entry via online booking system additional classes can be entered on the day
- 3. A horse/pony may only be entered once in each class. A rider can ride more than one horse/pony per class.

- 5. Snaffle bridles (NO Wilkie Snaffles) in equitation classes no martingales or boots.
- 6. No outside assistance in any class.
- 7. No lunging on the show field without permission from the DC.
- 8. All hair should be securely tied up and in a hair net.
- 9. Pony club members wishing to wear spurs must have written permission from their DC.
- 10. No pony to jump more than four classes in one day (show jumping and working hunter)
- 11. **Heights are provided on the schedule are a guideline only**. The judge has the right to build the course as deemed appropriate.
- 12. ALL Competitors must compete in show gear
- 13 If you are doing Lead Rein Jumping / Working Hunter, the only class you can enter off lead rein is class 2a Beginners Equitation. If you enter a lead rein class, then you are to be on lead rein all day (you can have a go at the assisted classes, but you would have to be non-competitive and you can do class 2a competitively).
