



Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club

One Day Event Schedule

8th June 2025

Westmorland Show Gound (LA7 7NH) and Helsington (LA9 5RH)

Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club are running a joint One Day Event. This will comprise the following elements:

- Dressage and Show jumping at the Westmorland Show Ground as part of the Lakes Riding Club's normal Combined Training Show.
- 'Cross Country' for lead rein and first ridden ponies over working hunter fences in the field adjacent to the Westmorland Show Ground.
- Cross Country for all other heights and combinations at the Horse Trials held by Oxenholme Pony Club at Helsington.

Competitors will enter **both** the Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club events as described for each class below. If they select to undertake the One Day Event their scores will be combined to the relevant classes to give an overall placing. Lakes Riding Club event will continue to be run as a Combined Training only event for those who are not undertaking the One Day Event and anyone doing both will still receive the normal points and be eligible for the Dressage Championship qualification as appropriate.

There will be no extra cost to be part of the one-day event, the costs will be covered through the normal entry fees as follows:

- Lakes Riding Club Combined Training:
 - LRC Members - £17
 - Non-members - £22
- Oxenholme Pony Club Horse Trials:
 - OPC Members – £30
 - Other PC Members - £35
 - Non-members – £40

Entries for Lakes Riding Club will be taken via Horse Monkey (www.horsemonkey.com) and for Oxenholme Pony Club (<https://branches.pcuk.org/oxenholme/calendar/>).

Process for Entering

Each show must be entered separately.

For Lead Rein and First Ridden 10 yrs and under enter class 1d for Lakes Riding Club and Class 1 for Oxenholme Pony Club.

For all other entries choose the dressage test or class you wish to undertake at Lakes Riding Club and enter the relevant Class as per the list or table below and then enter Oxenholme Pony Club picking the relevant age category for juniors and for seniors, novice or open.

The above enables all LRC usual competitors to enter their normal classes and gain points as usual as well as undertaking the Hunter Trials to be part of the One Day Event.

Processes for the Shows

Anyone competing in the One Day Event will undertake their dressage first for which a time will be given. These will be available on Thursday 5th June via the Lakes Riding Club Website and sent out via Horse Monkey. Once the dressage is complete then show jumping will take place on the same field and you should present yourself to the show jumping collecting ring.

Lead rein and first ridden entrants should then present themselves to the collecting area for the pony club 'cross country' in the adjacent field. All other competitors will box their horses and drive to Helsington to undertake their cross country.

Riders are asked to report to the secretary's caravan at Lakes Riding Club with their passport on the day to declare and collect their number and then to repeat this at Helsington when they arrive there.

Times will be provided for the X-Country element at Helsington, these will be available once entries have closed and will be posted on the Oxenholme Pony Club Website.

Rules and Scoring

Each show will be run under its normal rules; competitors **must** read the relevant schedule for the full rules for that show and websites for organisational rules. The LRC Combined Training is run under BD and BRC rules and the OPC is run under pony club rules.



For the One Day Event scoring the penalty scores for the dressage and showjumping with Lakes Riding Club and the cross-country element (working hunter fences for lead rein and first ridden) with Oxenholme Pony club will be added to give an overall score. The lowest penalty score being the winner.

Any ties will be considered in the following order:

- Lowest X-Country penalties
- Closest to the optimum time
- Highest 'good' dressage marks

Scoring will be undertaken during the day across the two venues and placings given at both venues as they become available during the day.



Classes and Entries

Class 10 – Lead Rein

Open to any lead rein combination 7 yrs and under.

Test – BD Introductory test 4 (2024)

Show jumping – 30 cm cross poles

Cross Country – 30 cm cross poles (this will take place over Working Hunter fences on the Westmorland Show Ground)

Enter Class 1d of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping (this is an additional class for this event only and will not be found in the normal schedule)

Enter Class 1 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for cross country equivalent element.

Class 11 – First Ridden

Open to any first ridden combination 10 yrs and under

Test – BD Introductory test 4 (2024)

Show jumping – 40 cm cross poles

Cross Country – 50 cm cross poles (this will take place over Working Hunter fences on the Westmorland Show Ground)

Enter Class 1d of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping (this is an additional class for this event only and will not be found in the normal schedule)

Enter Class 1 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for cross country equivalent element.

All remaining classes will follow the Classes from the normal Lakes Riding Club Schedule.



Prelim Section

Class 2c – **Novice Prelim** Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.25.

Test BD Prelim 2 (2024).

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 2c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 4 if 18 or 19 yrs.

Class 5 if 20yrs or over and novice rider (not to have competed at BE90 or above)

Class 6 if 20 yrs All other over riders.

Class 2d – **Novice Prelim** Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.25.

Test BD Prelim 2 (2024).

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter Class 2c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 2 – 4 based on age of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs

Class 3 if 14 – 16 yrs

Class 4 if 17 yrs.

Class 3c – **Open Prelim** (short arena). Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.25.

Test - BD Prelim 1 (2024)

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 3c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 4 if 18 or 19 yrs.

Class 5 if 20yrs or over and novice rider (not to have competed at BE90 or above)

Class 6 if 20 yrs All other over riders.

Class 3d – **Combined Training Open Prelim** (short arena) Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.25.

Test BD Prelim 1 (2024).

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence



Enter Class 2c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping
Enter Class 2 – 4 based on age of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs

Class 3 if 14 – 16 yrs

Class 4 if 17 yrs.

Class 4b – Open Prelim (long arena) Open to juniors and seniors, there is no separate junior section in this class.

Test BD Prelim 5 (2024)

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 4b of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs

Class 3 if 14 – 16 yrs

Class 4 if 18 or 19 yrs.

Class 5 if 20yrs or over and novice rider (not to have competed at BE90 or above)

Class 6 if 20 yrs All other over riders.



Novice Section

Class 5c – **Novice** (short arena) Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.25.

Test BD Novice 1 (2024)

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 5c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 4 if 18 or 19 yrs.

Class 5 if 20yrs or over and novice rider (not to have competed at BE90 or above)

Class 6 if 20 yrs All other over riders.

Class 5d – **Novice** (short arena) Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.25.

Test BD Novice 1 (2024)

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter Class 2c of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 2 – 4 based on age of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs

Class 3 if 14 – 16 yrs

Class 4 if 17 yrs.

Class 6b – **Open Novice** (Long arena) Open to juniors and seniors, there are no separate sections.

Test BD Novice 4 (2024).

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 6b of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

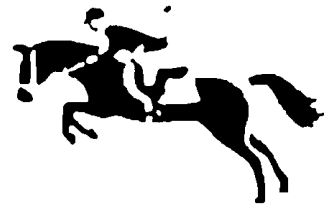
Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs

Elementary Section

Class 7b - Elementary (Long Arena) Open to juniors and seniors, there are no separate sections.

Test BD Elementary 4 (2024).

Show jumping – select height at time of entry

Cross Country – pick a fence

Enter class 6b of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

Enter Class 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 of Oxenholme Pony Club event for Cross Country.

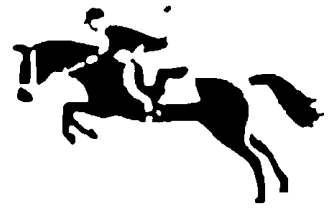
Class 2 if 11 – 13 yrs
