



## Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club

### One Day Event Schedule

**14<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

**Westmorland Show Gound (LA7 7NH) and Helsington (LA9 5RH)**

Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club are running a joint One Day Event. This will comprise the following elements:

- Dressage and Show jumping at the Westmorland Show Ground as part of the Lakes Riding Club's normal Combined Training Show.
- 'Cross Country' for lead rein and first ridden ponies over working hunter fences at the Westmorland Show Ground.
- Cross Country for all other heights and combinations at the Horse Trials held by Oxenholme Pony Club at Helsington.

Competitors undertaking phases at both the Westmorland Show Ground and Helsington will enter **both** the Lakes Riding Club and Oxenholme Pony Club events as described for each class below. If they select to undertake the One Day Event their scores will be combined to the relevant classes to give an overall placing. Lakes Riding Club event will continue to be run as a Combined Training only event for those who are not undertaking the One Day Event and anyone doing both will still receive the normal points and be eligible for the Dressage Championship qualification as appropriate.

**Lead Rein and First Ridden** competitors who will compete at the Westmorland Show Ground only, need only enter the Lakes Riding Club event.

There will be no extra cost to be part of the one-day event, the costs will be covered through the normal entry fees as follows:

- Lakes Riding Club Combined Training:
  - LRC Members - £17
  - Non-members - £22
  - Lead Rein and First Ridden - £22
- Oxenholme Pony Club Horse Trials:
  - All Competitors £40 plus £5 First Aid



All entries will be taken via Horse Monkey ([www.horsemonkey.com](http://www.horsemonkey.com)).

### **Process for Entering**

All entries will be taken via Horse Monkey, the link will be made available via Facebook and email.

For Lead Rein and First Ridden 10 yrs and under enter classes 10 and 11 respectively with Lakes Riding Club.

For all other classes choose the combined training class you wish to undertake at Lakes Riding Club and enter the relevant cross-country class to be undertaken with Oxenholme Pony club at Helsington. The remainder of the schedule and the table at the end show the classes to enter.

The above enables all LRC usual competitors to enter their normal classes and gain points as usual as well as undertaking the Hunter Trials to be part of the One Day Event.

### **Processes for the Shows**

Anyone competing in the One Day Event will undertake their dressage first for which a time will be given. These will be available on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June via the Lakes Riding Club Website and sent out via Horse Monkey. Once the dressage is complete then show jumping will take place on the same field and you should present yourself to the show jumping collecting ring.

All competitors undertaking their cross-country at Helsington will then box their horses and drive to Helsington to undertake their cross country. Times will be provided for the X-Country element at Helsington, these will be available once entries have closed and will be posted on the Oxenholme Pony Club Website. You can walk the course from 2pm on the Saturday.

Lead rein and first ridden entrants who are staying on the Westmorland Show Field will be asked to undertake their show jumping and 'cross country' fences during a set period of the day, which will be communicated by the secretary on the field.



Riders are asked to report to the secretary's caravan at Lakes Riding Club with their passport on the day to declare and collect their number and then to repeat this at Helsington when they arrive there.

### **Rules and Scoring**

Each show will be run under its normal rules; competitors **must** read the relevant schedule for the full rules for that show and websites for organisational rules. The LRC Combined Training is run under BD and BRC rules and the OPC is run under pony club rules.

For the One Day Event scoring the penalty scores for the dressage and showjumping with Lakes Riding Club and the cross-country element (working hunter fences for lead rein and first ridden) with Oxenholme Pony club will be added to give an overall score. The lowest penalty score being the winner.

- The dressage will be scored under BD rules and the penalties percentage penalties calculated to use in the one day event.
- The show jumping will be scored under BRC show jumping scoring with penalties added to the penalty score from the dressage. For the two open sections the round will also be timed and scored against an optimum time.
- The cross country will be scored under BRC cross country scoring, no penalties will be allocated related to the height of fence jumped other than where an incorrect height of fence is jumped which will lead to disqualification. Oncourse penalties will be added to the dressage and showjumping faults to give an overall score. For the two open sections the round will also be timed and scored against an optimum time.

Any ties will be considered in the following order:

- Lowest X-Country penalties
- Closest to the optimum time
- Highest 'good' dressage marks

Scoring will be undertaken during the day across the two venues and placings given at both venues as they become available during the day.



## **Classes and Entries**

### **Lead rein and first ridden**

#### **Class 10 – Lead Rein**

Open to any lead rein combination 3 - 7 yrs.

Test – BD Introductory test 1 (2024)

Show jumping – 30 cm cross poles

Cross Country – 30 cm cross poles (this will take place over Working Hunter fences on the Westmorland Show Ground)

Enter Class 10 of Lakes Riding Club show for all elements (this is an additional class for this event only and will not be found in the normal schedule).

#### **Class 11 – First Ridden** – with X-country phase over Working Hunter Fences at Westmorland Show Ground

Open to any first ridden combination 10 yrs and under

Test – BD Introductory test 1 (2024)

Show jumping – 40 cm cross poles

Cross Country – 50 cm cross poles (this will take place over Working Hunter fences on the Westmorland Show Ground)

**Enter Class 11** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping (this is an additional class for this event only and will not be found in the normal schedule)

All remaining classes will follow the Classes from the normal Lakes Riding Club Schedule.



## **Prelim Section**

**Class 2c** – **Novice Prelim** Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.26.

Test BRC Prelim A (2025).

Show jumping – Up to 70cm height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

**Enter class 2c** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 12** – for the Cross Country

**Class 2d** – **Novice Prelim** Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.26.

Test BRC Prelim A (2025).

Show jumping – Up to 70cm height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

**Enter Class 2d** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 13** – for the Cross Country

**Class 2e** – **First Ridden – with cross country over tiny fences at Helsington.**

Open to first ridden juniors.

Test BRC Prelim A (2025).

Show jumping – Up to 60cm height

Cross Country – Tiny fences only

**Enter Class 2d** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 14** – for the Cross Country

**Class 3c** – **Senior Prelim** (short arena). Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.26.

Test – BRC Prelim B (2025)

Show jumping – Any height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

**Enter class 3c** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 15** – for the Cross Country

**Class 3d** – **Junior Prelim** (short arena) Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.26.

Test – BRC Prelim B (2025)

Show jumping – Up to 80cm height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

**Enter Class 3d** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 16** – for the Cross Country

**Class 3e** – **Open Prelim – Open Jumping** (short arena). Open to riders of any age.

Test – BRC Prelim B (2025)

Show jumping – 80 cm height, timed round

Cross Country – medium and large fences with up to 3 small fences – timed round

**Enter class 3c or 3d relevant to your age for** Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

**Enter Class 17** for the Cross Country



## Novice Section

**Class 5c – Senior Novice** (short arena) Open to seniors 18yrs and over on 1.01.26.

Test BD Novice 2 (2024)

Show jumping – 70 or 80cm height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

***Enter class 5c*** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

***Enter Class 18*** for the Cross Country

**Class 5d – Junior Novice** (short arena) Open to juniors 17yrs and under on 1.01.26.

Test BD Novice 2 (2024)

Show jumping – 70 or 80cm height

Cross Country – Tiny / small or medium fences only

***Enter Class 5d*** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

***Enter Class 19*** for the Cross Country

**Class 5e – Open Novice – Open Jumping** (short arena). Open to riders of any age.

Test BD Novice 2 (2024)

Show jumping – 80 cm or above, timed round

Cross Country – medium and large fences with up to 3 small fences – timed round

***Enter class 5c or 5d relevant to you age*** of Lakes Riding Club show for dressage and show jumping

***Enter Class 19*** for the Cross Country
