

## Mini Achievement Badge : Fire Safety



Have you got fire extinguishers in your yard? Do you know where they are?

Do you know the fire drill for your yard and how you would evacuate the horses?

Never smoke anywhere in the stable yard, barns, trailers or in horse boxes

The most common causes of fires in farms and equestrian facilities are :

- Electrical
- Smoking
- Flammable Materials
- Cylinders
- Arson
- Fertiliser

What to do in the event of a fire ...

Put the following in the correct order :

- Call the Fire Brigade
- Fight the fire
- Evacuate the stables
- Sounds the Fire Alarm or Shout to alert everyone



How can we prevent fires?

- Keep the stable area neat and tidy at all times
- Knock down cobwebs
- Rake loose straw and hay from aisle ways
- Do not store hay/straw/shavings bales close to the stables
- Site the manure heap a safe distance away from the stables
- Have at least one large NO SMOKING sign by each stable block
- Remove flammable gases/engine oil/tractor fuel from stable area


