RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
4. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
5. Please read all rules as above on The Pony Club website www.pcuk.org. A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
6. Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. After due consideration of the objection, the judge's decision is final.
7. Withdrawals - £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £5.00 admin fee).
8. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2023. All hats to be checked when collecting numbers. Dark blue, black or brown hats only.
9. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class.
10. Horses or ponies must be over four years old on the day of the competition.
11. No galloping anywhere on the showground, riders must only walk their horses/ponies in the car park.
No lungeing on show ground.
12. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
13. **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
14. **Health and Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
15. **Privacy Notice:** Please note that we will be publishing the competitors' times and results on our website, this will include competitors' name, horse name, branch and full results. If you wish your details to be excluded from these publications, please make a note of this on your entry form. Please refer to our branch privacy policy on our website.
