Withdrawals and refunds

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a team or an individual **prior to the closing date for entries** to the competition, a full refund will be given, less an administration charge.

Withdrawals after the closing date for entries will NOT be refunded except on the production of a vet's or doctor's certificate.

In the event of abandonment 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Rosettes and prize giving

Rosettes for individuals: 1st – 8th per Area

Rosettes for teams: 1st – 6th per Area

Craddock rosettes will be awarded to all competitors in the PC100 and Chairman's Cup who achieve clear rounds in both the show jumping and cross country without time penalties.

All results will be available on [PonyClubResults](#) on the day.

Prize giving will be in the pavilion and prize winners must be correctly dressed.

Entry Conditions

- To be run in accordance with **Pony Club Eventing Rules 2023**
- Competitors, and those who are responsible for them, must be conversant with the PC Eventing Rule Book 2023, particularly with regard to **dress and tack**.
- Competitors must ensure their **numbers** are downloaded and **printed (not handwritten)** from the link on [PonyClubResults](#) when times are published. Two numbers, front and back, must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- Competitors must bring their own **number bib**.
- **Entry Queries** should be raised with your DC/Centre Proprietor
- **No horse** will be allowed to compete in 2 classes.
- **Photographic Rights** – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

- A valid **passport and vaccination** record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rules 2023 – **please refer to the website.**

- On the day only DCs/Centre Proprietors or their appointed representatives are entitled to lodge a protest or objection. Protests/objections will be managed as per Eventing Rule book 2023, page 9.
