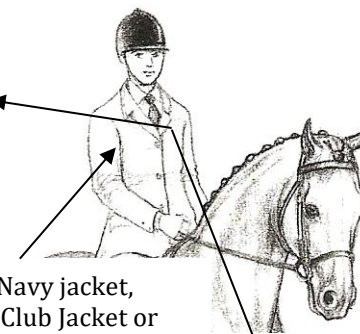


W elcome to the Petersfield Pony Club

This sheet is designed to help you prepare for a Pony Club Rally

Clean your tack, so it is soft and supple.

Check your tack is in good working order, paying particular attention to the wear on the stitching



Tweed, Black or Navy jacket, Petersfield Pony Club Jacket or sweatshirt. Older members may wear coloured stock (Tweed jacket) or white stock (black/navy jacket)

Pony Club Badge with the Test felt behind it on the left lapel

Hat tagged by the DC or Secretary to show it confirms to Pony Club Standards

Regularly check your hat fits correctly and the harness is secure

Hat covers may be black, dark blue or brown

Hairnet recommended. Jewellery is not recommended.

A white or blue collared, long sleeved shirt with a Pony Club tie. A stock may be worn by older members, if preferred with a Petersfield Pony Club sweatshirt

Medical Arm Band recommended

Whip a plain colour (without a loop on the handle)

Cream or light coloured jodhpurs

Chaps (optional) should be brown or black, with no tassels

Polishable jodhpur boots or riding boots, with a smooth sole

Pony's feet should be regularly shod or trimmed

Your Pony should be groomed and well turned out, with a tidy mane and tail

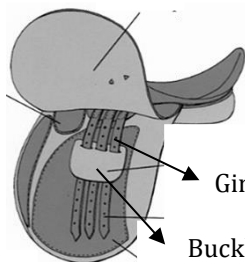
Gloves should be a plain colour

Neck straps may be used by younger members and those on young ponies

Browbands, numnahs and brushing boots in plain colours

Reins and checkpieces checked regularly for wear

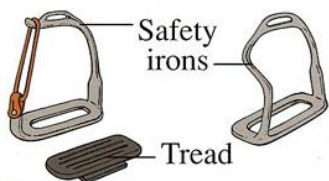
The girth the correct length for the pony: not too long or too short



Girth straps in good condition

Buckle guards in place

Stirrups the correct size for boots. Safety stirrups with treads are recommended.



Stirrup leathers should be equal in length, with enough holes to shorten and lengthen them and the stitching next to the buckle in good condition.

Body protectors are recommended for all jumping and are **compulsory** when jumping cross country fences.

In wet weather wear a plain waterproof coat or a Petersfield Pony Club Jacket may be worn.

Notes:

- Arrive in good time
- Tell the DC, or Rally Co-ordinator you have arrived
- Be mounted ready to ride at least 10 minutes before your ride time (this allows your pony time to settle and to have your tack checked) Parents are also free to help with jumps/arenas, if necessary

After the Rally:

- Remember to thank your Instructor and the DC/Rally Co-ordinator
- Pick up any droppings in the arena, around your trailer etc
- Offer to help move jumps if necessary
