It is with great excitement we invite our members to join us at a fantastic new venue for Senior Camp this year. Littleton Manor Equestrian is a 46 acre site, run by Kate and Matt Tarrant, near Reigate. They have been running camps for 14 years now, so are really well set up.

The equestrian facilities boast:

- a cross country course designed by Willis Brothers who also design for Badminton. This has been used to host BE events, and has a variety of jumps, ditches, and a water complex (jumps 60cm - 1m+)
- Gallops
- 2 recently re-surfaced arenas (one with an entire side of mirrors and the other is a huge showjumping school) plus an optional grass arena should we need it.

For the campers there is a marquee for eating and hanging out.

Campers need to provide their own sleeping accommodation (tent, trailers, or lorries welcome). We can help you find people to share with if needed.

All meals are provided.

Your horses and ponies will be sleeping in wooden show stables close to us.

This year Camp will start on the evening of Bank Holiday Monday, and finish around 4.00 pm on Friday, after clearing away.

This year we will NOT be running the competitions, due to feedback from previous years, so expect more instruction, more fun and maximum time in the saddle!

Senior Camp is suitable for those happy and competent to ride in open spaces and in company, and able to look after their pony. Generally aimed at ages 12+ we can make exceptions, please talk to us.

Booking will open in the next few days on Entrymaster.

Costs are expected to be around **£425.00** per rider, dependant on final numbers. The initial deposit is **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
