



RULES

All persons entering the grounds shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions

- 1. All Showjumping is run under Pony Club 2024 Rules: Pony Club Showjumping Rule Book 2024
- 2. All riding hats must conform to Pony Club Rules 2024 and must be worn and securely fastened at all times when mounted.
- 3. A body protector, if worn must conform to Pony Club specifications: Pony Club Body Protector Rule 2024
- 4. No galloping on the Show ground
- 5. No lungeing on the Show Ground.
- 6. Horses/ponies <u>must NOT</u> be left unattended when tied up to lorries/trailers.
- 7. Pony Club Dress Rules to apply. **Jackets to be worn unless permission given due to warm weather**.
- 8. All Lead Reins must be attached to either the noseband or headcollar.
- 9. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300 THREE copies (1 for front of bib; 1 for back of bib and 1 for your vehicle). Bring your own number bib.
- 10. Any objection to be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00.
- 11. Withdrawals a £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, <u>subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.</u>
- 12. Should the Show be cancelled the organisers reserve the right to withhold £5.00 of each entry fee to offset costs.
- 13. In the case of **abandonment**, no refunds will be given except at the discretion of the organising committee.
- 14. All Trophies, which will be awarded to Petersfield Pony Club members, and all Rosettes will be awarded on the day.
- 15. Competitors who are not members of The Pony Club are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Petersfield Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 16. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 17. **Reasonable Adjustment**: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by *Monday 19 August 2024*.
