Trinity had a disappointing shoot on Saturday morning scoring 760, she just wasn't feeling it, but had a great (and best) swim at 10 lengths 7 metres. 1 metre off her pb, but not bad, and this pulled her up to third place overnight.

We walked the XC on Saturday afternoon and it was full up 1 metre and quite technical, with a lot of combinations, dog legs and drops on the landing side. Trinity was not happy!

This was going to be their first 1m course and only their second ever full XC course together. They had also not yet had an opportunity to practice opening and shutting gates and doing the slip rail together.



Thankfully, the rain held off on Sunday morning and Trinity set off. Florida gave Trinity a fabulous ride and they came back clear and inside the time! She had jumped all the super scary fences beautifully and put a massive smile on Trinity's face.

This still left Trinity in third, but only 31 points behind the leader with the run to come and by this time it had started raining, a lot! Trinity knew she had to beat the girls in front of her by at least 10 seconds, which she did, and then some, giving her, her first win at the higher level.
