

LEAGUE RULES:

- This League is for Pony Club Members only.
- > League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- > Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- > N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.
- > Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- Points will be counted from all 5 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 23 February at the Petersfield Dressage competition.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
- 2. The Judge's decision is final.
- 3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
- 4. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
- 5. Please read all rules as above on The Pony Club website: **The Pony Club**. A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
- 6. Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. After due consideration of the objection, the judge's decision is final.
- 7. Withdrawals £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £5.00 admin fee).
- 8. Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ Test OR the NEW Spurs
 Test
- 9. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. All hats to be checked when collecting numbers. Dark blue, black or brown hats only.
- 10. Body Protectors (if worn), must comply with BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) is the only acceptable safety standard.
- 11. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class.
- 12. Horses or ponies must be over four years old on the day of the competition.
- 13. No galloping anywhere on the showground, riders must only walk their horses/ponies in the car park.
- 14. **No lungeing** on show ground.
- 15. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
- 16. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 17. **Reasonable Adjustment**: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by *Monday 03 February 2025*.
