JUDGING:

The least jumping penalties plus nearest the 'Bogey Time' will determine results.

- > Competitors will be eliminated after 3 refusals at one jump, after 4 refusals over whole course.
- Riders at PC70 and PC80 may be allowed to continue at the discretion of the Official Steward/Jump Judge.
- > Riders will be eliminated at their first fall and will not be permitted to continue.


NOTE:

- > Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ Test OR the NEW Spurs Test
- > Please display your number at front of vehicle.
- > Failure to report 15 mins before the correct time will mean the rider risks elimination.
- A tack check will be in operation.

Course may be walked from 2.00 pm on Friday 18 April 2025






RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Full results will be posted on Petersfield Pony Club's website

- 1. The event will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2025 on The Pony Club website <u>www.pcuk.org</u>
- 2. All riding hats/body protectors must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. Back protectors are compulsory. Air jackets ARE NOT to be worn under any item of clothing.
- 3. The judge's decision is final in all matters. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the conditions or competitions, classes, or sections, as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion. Objections must be lodged in writing within 30



minutes of the incident, together with a £10.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

- 4. Withdrawals £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £10.00 admin fee)
- 5. In the event of cancellation prior to the event a ± 10.00 admin charge will be made. If the event is cancelled on the day, there will be no refund.
- 6. Entries will be limited and will <u>not</u> be accepted by telephone.
- 7. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300 **THREE** copies (1 for front of bib; 1 for back of bib and 1 for your vehicle).
- 8. Bring your own number bib.
- 9. Horses and ponies may only enter ONE class.
- 10. Any competitor in difficulty at a fence, must make way for a following competitor, who is about to overtake.
- 11. Competitors who are not members of The Pony Club are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Petersfield Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 12. Please take all litter and droppings home with you.
- 13. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 14. **Reasonable Adjustment**: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty.
