Class 1A: <u>AREA 13 PC70 REGIONAL QUALIFIER inc TEAMS | PONY CLUB MEMBERS ONLY</u>

Fences: Showjumping 0.75m max height. Cross Country 0.70m max height. Members must be aged 13 and under on 1 January of the current year. Combination of horse and rider are **NOT** eligible if they have:

- > Previously completed at any PC80 or above Area or Regional competitions for Eventing.
- Achieved more than two cross country rounds with no jumping penalties at BE (or EI) 80 or above.

Class 1B: PC70 | <u>OPEN TO ALL</u>

Fences: Showjumping 0.75m max height. Cross Country 0.70m max height. Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st - 3rd in any cross country event above this height in the last 3 years.

Class 2: AREA 13 PC70+ REGIONAL QUALIFIER | PONY CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

Fences: Showjumping 0.75m max height. Cross Country 0.70m max height.

This is solely for individuals. There is no team competition. Members must be aged 14 and over on 1 January of the current year.

Combination of horse and rider are **NOT** eligible if they have:

- Previously completed at any PC80 or above Area or Regional competition for Eventing.
- Achieved more than two cross country rounds with no jumping penalties at BE (or EI) 80 or above.

Class 3A: AREA 13 PC80 REGIONAL QUALIFIER in TEAMS | PONY CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

Fences: Showjumping 0.85m max height. Cross Country 0.80m max height. Combination of horse and rider are **NOT** eligible if they have:

> Previously completed at PC90 or above in any Eventing Area Competitions.

Achieved more than two cross country rounds with no jumping penalties at BE (or EI) 90 or above.

Fences: Showjumping 0.85m max height. Cross Country 0.80m max height. Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st - 3rd in any cross country event above this height in the last 3 years.

PHASE II SHOW JUMPING:

At PC90 and PC100, competitors incurring more than 24 Showjumping penalties will not be allowed to go Cross Country. Competitors at PC70 and PC80 may be allowed to do so only at the discretion of the Official Steward.

At all Levels, competitors eliminated for technical reasons (e.g., starting before the bell or an error of course) may be allowed to go Cross Country at the discretion of the Official Steward.

First fall of rider or horse – Elimination.

PHASE III CROSS COUNTRY:

Competitors are eliminated after 3 refusals at any one jump, or 4 refusals over whole course.

Competitors at PC70 and PC80 only may sometimes be allowed to continue after the fourth cumulative refusal at the discretion of the Official Steward.

At PC70 there will be no penalties for going too slowly, but reverse time penalties will be applied for going too fast.

Fall of horse | Elimination. Fall of rider anywhere on the course | Elimination.

The course may be walked from 2.00 pm on Saturday 21 June 2025 – finish by 7.00 pm

- > All hats and back protectors worn in the competition will be checked on arrival; please have ready in the front of your vehicle.

Branches/Clubs may enter up to THREE teams of 3 or 4 competitors (best 3 scores to count) for each level.

<u>Note</u>: teams will be split as evenly as possible between the arenas.

<u>RULES</u>

- 1. These Horse Trials are open to all but will be run in accordance with the rules of the Pony Club Eventing 2024. If you are unsure of the correct dress for yourself and turnout of your horse or pony in any of the three phases, please check **Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2025** It is the responsibility of competitors to comply with the Rules.
- 2. <u>Vaccinations will be required according to Pony Club Rules 2025</u>. It is illegal to travel your horse without its passport; spot checks may be carried out.
- 3. All riding hats must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. A jockey skull with no fixed peak must be worn for all cross country at 0.80m and above.
- 4. Back protectors are compulsory for the cross country phase. Back protectors used for cross country must meet BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label). Air Jackets **ARE NOT** to be worn under any item of clothing. If worn it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector which meets the above standard. Medical Armbands are recommended and if used **MUST** be worn on the arm.
- 5. Spurs: may not be worn by a Pony Club member at a Pony Club activity or event unless that member has passed either the Pony Club C+ Riding Test or the Pony Club Spurs Test.
- 6. Dressage phase: A whip with a maximum length of 102cm (measured up to the tassel) may be carried at PC70 and PC80, but no whips are allowed at PC90 or PC100.
- 7. Electronic devices not allowed while rider is competing. Stop watches permitted at PC90 and above.
- 8. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300. Bring your own number bib.
- 9. Withdrawals before close of entries will get a full refund less a £10.00 admin fee. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.
- 10. Should the Show be cancelled the organisers reserve the right to withhold £10.00 of each entry fee to offset costs.
- 11. In the case of **abandonment**, no refunds will be given except at the discretion of the organising committee.
- 12. Horse/pony may compete in only one class.
- 13. Competitors will be required to report to stewards for all phases <u>15 minutes</u> before their time. Failure to comply will carry the risk of elimination.
- 14. All stallions must wear identifying disc on their bridle written permission needed from DC/Centre Head.
- 15. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- **16. Reasonable Adjustment**: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by *Sunday 1 June 2025*. - 17. **Health & Safety**: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
- 18. **Insurance:** All non-members competing at a Pony Club organised event, should have their own Third-Party Liability Insurance.
