Rosettes to 6th place in each section

Rosette to the highest placed Petersfield Member in all Classes

**For Classes 1 – 4 Teams will be made up of 3 or 4 riders from a Pony Club Branch/Riding Club etc
with the best 3 scores to count**

**For Classes 5 and 6 this can be combined Teams of 2 or 3 riders
Team Rosettes to 4th place**

LEAGUE RULES:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter – they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- **N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.**
- Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- Points will be counted from all 7 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th places.
- **New for 2025/26 will also be an Area 13 "Top of the Tests" Winners – a winner rosette will be given to the person who does the best at each of the 6 competition levels.**
- **Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 22 February at the Petersfield PC competition at Priory Equestrian Centre.**

Prizes to include:

- Overall League – Rosettes 1st - 10th place, Sash for Winner and prizes for 1st - 3rd place
- Top of the Tests Winner – Rosette for 1st Place and prizes



The competition will be run in accordance with The Pony Club Dressage 2026 Rule Book

Working in will be on the 60m x 27m outdoor surface

Please will competitors report to the Tack Check Steward 15 minutes
before the time allotted for their test

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
4. Please read all rules as above on The Pony Club website: [The Pony Club](#). A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
5. Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. After due consideration of the objection, the judge's decision is final.
6. Withdrawals before close of entries will get a full refund less a £10.00 admin fee. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.
7. Should the Show be cancelled the organisers reserve the right to withhold £10.00 of each entry fee to offset costs.
8. In the case of abandonment, no refunds will be given except at the discretion of the organising committee.
9. **Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ Test OR the Spurs Test.**
10. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2026. All hats to be checked when collecting numbers. Dark blue, black or brown hats only.
11. **Body Protectors (if worn) must comply with BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) is the only acceptable safety standard.**
12. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class.
13. Horses or ponies must be over four years old on the day of the competition.
14. No galloping anywhere on the showground, riders must only walk their horses/ponies in the car park.
15. **No lungeing** on show ground.
16. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
17. **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
18. **Health & Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
19. **Reasonable Adjustment:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by **Monday 9 February 2026**.
