Dear Members and Parents

We enjoyed seeing so many of you at the Annual Party and Prize Giving in October and celebrating your achievements during the year – thank you again to Lindsay Kelly for allowing us to use her great venue for this event. We have another event coming up at the Forest Community Centre in January which is an information evening and an opportunity to find out how Pony Club works, to ask any questions you may have and hopefully to give us some new ideas. There is lots of important information in this Newsletter as we are trying to get dates in your diary for many of our activities next year. Booking info is enclosed with this Newsletter for our Lead Rein, Mini, Novice and Intermediate Easter Clinics and online booking for those will open very shortly on Eventmaster. Information and dates for Junior and Senior Camp are also included but we are not yet opening booking for either of those. We know that with booking comes a deposit and that this is an expensive time of year! So please put the dates in your diary for Junior and Senior Camp and do contact the organisers if you have any questions about either Camp. We will send out further information when booking opens later in the Spring.

We will also over the coming months be asking for help with our events during 2026. Please volunteer when you can as your help is essential to the successful running of our events, which raise vital funds for the branch.

The first two where we will need help in 2026 are our Dressage Show at Priory Equestrian on Sunday 22 February and our Hunter Trials at Fair Oak Cross Country on Sunday 19 April. No special skills are needed to help at our events – briefing will be given for all roles, and you don't need to be horsey to help. Most helpers enjoy the experience and have a good day out.

We have more Multi Activity Days and Showjumping and Mounted Games on offer as well as Stable Management over the winter. Please try to attend these rallies and trainings even when the weather doesn't feel that inviting.

The Dressage Show in February also has something to cater for most abilities including a Walk and Trot only Test to encourage our younger members to take part. We also hope to see all those members who have been honing their skills through the Dressage League! It is also an Open Show so entries from PC Mums/Dads welcome and do please spread the word to non-Pony Club friends and family.

Depending on the weather we hope that Cross Country Rallies will start again in March, giving you time for a bit of practise before our popular Hunter Trials in April at Fair Oak, with classes starting from 60cm.

Remember to keep a close eye on your pony or horse over the winter to make sure they don't lose too much condition. The combination of wet and cold is the worst possible combination for them to cope with.

Thank you to all of you for your support of Petersfield Pony Club over the year. We end the year with 80 members making us one of the bigger branches in our Pony Club Area.

And finally . . . although membership is now on a rolling basis, for many of our longer standing members your renewal will be due at the end of January at a cost of £95.00 (the majority of which goes to Head Office to pay for the overall PC operation rather than the Branch). IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS 10 and UNDER

If your pony does not have a martingale, make sure you always come to rallies, events etc with a stirrup leather around the pony's neck.

This is for you to hold onto when things do not go right to avoid pulling on your pony's mouth and perhaps to save you from falling off.



SAFETY AT RALLIES

Please can you all make sure that unless you are riding in a lesson, that you only walk (mounted/dismounted), especially when going from your trailer to the lesson. The car park is a potentially dangerous situation with a lot of ponies, children, dogs etc milling around. It is the responsibility of everyone present to ensure that all measures are taken to safeguard both ponies and people at all times. Please be aware of safety.

Air jackets: When an air jacket inflates the sudden noise startles horses in the immediate vicinity thereby causing difficulties for the other members of a ride if used in a group ride in a confined area, e.g., an indoor school or outdoor manège. Air jackets are therefore not encouraged for group rides.

Also, it is your responsibility to pick up any horse droppings and hay in the parking area and in the school – if that is where the lesson is taking place.

TURNOUT

Would you please all pay careful attention to turnout of yourselves and your pony/horse when attending all Rallies and Training. Please make sure your boots are polished, jodhpurs, tack etc are clean.

Your hair must be tied back securely, in a safe manner to reduce the risk of hair being caught and to prevent scalp injuries. A hairnet is therefore recommended.

The wearing of any sort of jewellery when handling or riding a horse/pony is not recommended and if done at any Pony Club activity, is done at the risk of the member/their parent/guardian. However, to stop any risk of injury, necklaces and bracelets (other than medical bracelets) must be removed, as must larger and more pendulous pieces of jewellery (including those attached to piercings) which create a risk of injury to the body part through which they are secured. For the avoidance of doubt a wristwatch, wedding ring, stock pin worn horizontally and/or a tie clip are permitted. It is recommended that stock pins are removed for cross country.

PARENTS & MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE:
STIRRUPS

Ensure that your stirrups and boots fit correctly. For very good safety reasons, Pony Club rules require the following: **“Standard riding or jodhpur boots with a fairly thin, smooth sole and a well-defined square cut heel”** and **“Stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider’s boots. There must be 7mm (¼”) clearance on either side of the boot”**.

These rules together with the requirement not to wear other unsuitable footwear including boots and stirrups with interlocking treads, are there to minimise the risk of the foot becoming caught in the stirrup in a fall which can cause very serious injuries. If you are buying new boots check the size of stirrups with the new boots.

At competitions this is probably the most common problem picked up by tack checkers. We will be checking this at our MADs over the winter and will advise you if your stirrups are the wrong size, but please also check yourself.

If you go to a Pony Club competition with incorrect size stirrups, you may not be allowed to take part.

BADGES/TIES/SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS

These are always kept in stock; please contact me. If you need The Pony Club Manual of Horsemanship these can be purchased from Amazon – a must if you are taking Tests.

Medical Arm Bands are no longer compulsory wear, but it is still recommended that one is worn.

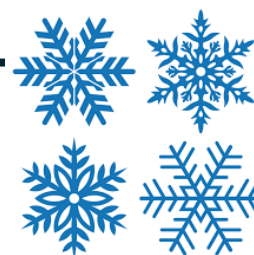

VOLUNTEERS FOR BLUE CROSS COMPETITION NEEDED

Are there any members who enjoy testing their knowledge? We need volunteers for this practical Quiz (unmounted) to pit their wits against other Area 13 teams.



The competition features teams of 3 members who demonstrate their knowledge and practical horsemanship skills taken from the Pony Club Tests over a number of rounds.

Teams compete at their Area Competition with the aim to qualify for the JCB Championships at Offchurch Bury in August.

- **Minis:** Questions to be based on the Care section of the E, D and D+ Test cards and Mini Horsemanship Achievement Badges. Teams to consist of three members. Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1 January of the competition year, with one Member to be 8 years or under on the 1 January of the competition year.
- **Juniors:** Questions to be based on the Care section of the D, D+, C and C+ Test cards and Horsemanship Achievement Badges. Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be **14** years and under on the 1 January of the competition year, with one Member to be 11 years or under on the 1 January of the competition year.
- **Seniors:** Questions to be based on the Care section of the C+, B and AH Test cards.

Teams make their way around different 'stations', each of which will comprise of a different theory or practical based topic. Ten minutes are spent at each 'station', during which time Members are asked a series of questions to be marked by the Assessor.

'D' and 'D+' TESTS | MINI ROAD RIDER & ROAD RIDER ACHIEVEMENT BADGES

The Pony Club Training structure encourages members to take Tests which enable them to learn progressively about horse and pony care and riding. The Tests are taken at recommended ages and begin with 'E' Test, Mini Road Rider Achievement Badge and 'D' Test. We feel these Tests are an important step on your horse owning ladder and can ultimately qualify you for a career in horses. We subsidise the costs of training and Tests with monies raised from competitions as part of encouraging all members to learn about horsemanship.

These are suitable for all members who have not yet taken any Tests, it would also be useful for you to attend the Stable Management Rallies to prepare you for the care questions. The Tests are all oral and practical and take place in small groups.

The Road Rider Achievement Badge **Theory** will be held via Zoom for both parts with Alex Van Randwyck (date to be confirmed). The riding part will be held at the Multi Activity Day **on Sunday 15 March** at Priory Equestrian.

The Mini Road Rider Achievement Badge part will also be held via Zoom with Alex (date to be confirmed).

'D' and 'D+' training and Tests will also be held on **Sunday 15 March** at the Multi Activity Day at Priory Equestrian. You will need to be 8 years old to take 'D' Test and 10 years old to take 'D+'.

We are lucky enough to be surrounded by several different hunts. Meet cards are held by the secretaries and you are usually able to hunt for two – three days a year without needing a subscription.

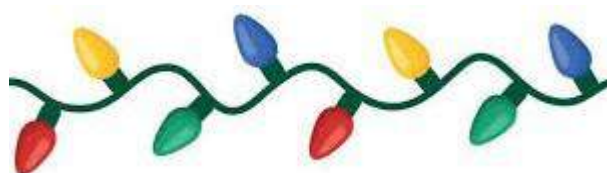
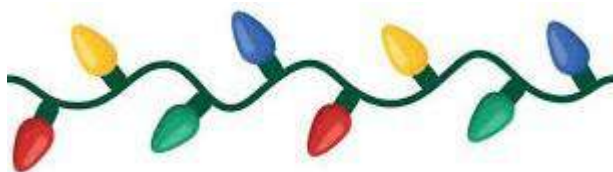
