Class 3	Open Fences approx 0.70m (2'3") Entry: £10 Rosettes to 10th place, cup to highest placed Portman Hunt Pony Club member BIG COURSE Classes 4-7 open to all – see times on website
Class 4	 (a) Under 14 years (b) Open Fences approx. 0.75m (2'6") Entry: £15 Rosettes to 6th place, cup to highest placed Portman Hunt Pony Club member
Class 5	Pairs Fences approx. 0.75m (2'6") Entry per pair: £30 Rosettes to 6th place
Class 6	(a) Under 14 years (b) Open

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

- Class sizes will be limited and rosettes to be awarded to the first ten in classes 1-3 and to the first six in classes 4-6. Rosette and cup to the best Portman Pony Club member in each individual class.
- 2. All entries must be made online at <u>www.equoevents.co.uk</u>.
- 3. Entries may be taken on the day, space allowing. To avoid disappointment (and a wasted journey) please check with entries secretary before setting out if not pre-entered.
- 4. No horse/pony may be entered in a class on the big course more than once and no horse/pony may run in more than 3 classes including pairs.
- 5. The small course (1'9 and 2'3) will be judged on style.
- 6. The big course will have a short timed section.
- 7. Pairs to be judged on style at dressing fences which will be marked on course plan.
- 8. Judges' decision will be final. Any person wishing to lodge an objection must do so to the secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £10.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, to divide any class and to refuse any entry without stating any reason. Anyone misbehaving in any way will be asked to leave.
