

Pony Club examining under current Covid-19 restrictions

Guidance for taking Pony Club Tests up to and including C test:

1 Assessor
1 Supervisor/First aider
4 Candidates

ALL attending parents to have been sent a copy of the PC's latest COVID-19 risk policy, sign and return to organiser.

Parking: to be suitably spaced between each lorry and trailer away from arena

One parent per child and no extra adults or children.

Parent to help child mount and then stay with their vehicles.

Riding Section:

Supervisor to guide the four candidates, whilst the assessor watches and examines them.

At all times they must adhere to the social distancing rules.

Supervisor should be gloved and masked to help if needed with tightening girths etc. Assessor and supervisor to carry a mask & gloves should they be required during the test.

Care Section:

Candidates must bring all their own equipment which may be needed in the test ie grooming kit, martingale and rugs, etc.

Ponies must be safely tied in the open air, not in stables, eg: along the side of an arena, or a wall, or maybe 4 lorries parked in an L shape with at least 4 metres between them, so the assessor can see them all at the same time and still be able to keep two metres away from them all.

Results:

While the assessor is sorting out the results, all the candidates should return to their vehicles and one at a time the supervisor should call the candidates with their one parent to come back to get their results from the assessor.

At no time can all the candidates and their accompanying adult have a meeting altogether. The supervisor can hand out the felts and certificates to the successful candidates, one at a time and outside in the open air.
