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## **ENTRIES**

- All entries to be made on Horse-Events
- Closing date for entries: Wednesday 15th January 2025 or before if classes are full
- Teams can be mixed gender in all classes. Individuals will be placed into mixed branch teams where possible. Class 4a Novices will be placed in Class 4 teams if possible.
- Start times will be available no later than Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January
- Full refunds will be given up until the closing date only
- In the event of cancellation/ abandonment of the event, the entry fee less £5 will be refunded for each competitor
- The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes depending on entries

### RULES

- Competitors must be paid up members of The Pony Club
- Ages are as at 1st January 2025, save that if you have not reached your 8th birthday by 26th January 2025 you must compete as a Beanie.
- To be run according to Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2024
- If you would like to object to or have us check scores, this must be requested by Branch Managers only, in writing, to official organisers, within 15 minutes of the scores being published
- Deposit of £10 with each query which is refundable if the query is upheld

### **SHOOT**

- The Open/Intermediate Class 5 will start the shooting
- Protective glasses are COMPULSORY for shooting at 7m.
- Guns must remain boxed until the range steward gives the order to "unbox" at the start of the detail
- and must be "boxed" again before the competitor leaves the firing point
- At all other times guns must be stored in their boxes and locked in a secure place or remain in the possession of an adult
- Pistols must be flagged before any person moves forward of the firing point during a detail
- No person under the age of 18 may be responsible for or carry a gun
- All shooting competitors must have received adequate shooting training
- Competitors to wear long trousers and suitable footwear that does not cover the ankle
- First-time competitors are very welcome but no first-time shooters

#### **SWIM**

- Buoyancy aids will be allowed in Class 1 only
- Only one parent/ guardian per child poolside please
- All competitors who wish to dive from the starting blocks need to have attained the Competitive Start award certificate
- If you have your Preliminary Competitive Start award certificate you may start from poolside
- If you do not have either you will have to start in the water. Please bring your certificates with you or email to lintownsend@hotmail.co.uk
- Parents of competitors must disclose allergies in relation to the swimming pool to the organiser, prior to the competition

# RUN

- All runs will be a mass/ group start of no more than 10
- No pacing allowed
- Inhalers cannot be carried and used whilst running

## RESULTS, ROSETTES, PRIZEGIVING

- Result will be available on ponyclubresults
- Rosettes to the first 6 individuals in each class
- Rosettes to first 3 individuals in each phase of each class
- Team rosettes will be awarded to first 6 teams in classes 1-4
