AREA 14 WINTER TRIATHLON ACCUMULATOR

This event is part of the Area 14 Accumulator, competitors to compete in at least 3 of the 5 eligible competitions to qualify, best 3 scores to count.

(NB: The winter League is for Area 14 members only. Competitors must enter the same class at each event)

ENTRIES

- All entries to be made on [Horse-Events](#) and accepted when paid fully
- Closing date for entries: **Wednesday 14th January 2026** or before if classes are full
- Teams can be mixed gender in all classes. Individuals will be placed into mixed branch teams where possible.
- Start times will be available no later than Wednesday 21st January
- Full refunds will be given up until the closing date only
- In the event of cancellation/ abandonment of the event, the entry fee less £5 will be refunded for each competitor
- The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes depending on entries

RULES

- Competitors must be paid up members of The Pony Club
- Ages are as at 1st January 2026, save that if you have not reached your 8th birthday by 25th January 2026 you must compete as a Beanie.
- To be run according to Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2025
- If you would like to object to or have us check scores, this must be requested by Branch Managers only, in writing on the Leweston Triathlon Query Form, to the organisers, within 15 minutes of the scores being published

SHOOT

- The Open Class 5 will start the shooting
- Protective glasses are **COMPULSORY** for shooting at 7m.
- Guns must remain boxed until the range steward gives the order to “unbox” at the start of the detail
- and must be “boxed” again before the competitor leaves the firing point
- At all other times guns must be stored in their boxes and locked in a secure place or remain in the possession of an adult
- Pistols must be flagged before any person moves forward of the firing point during a detail
- No person under the age of 18 may be responsible for or carry a gun
- All shooting competitors must have received adequate shooting training and confirmed by the Branch Tetrathlon Managers
- Competitors to wear long trousers and suitable footwear that does not cover the ankle
- First-time competitors are very welcome but no first-time shooters

SWIM

- Buoyancy aids will be allowed in Class 1 only
- Swimming hats must be worn in the pool
- Only one parent/ guardian per child poolside please
- All competitors who wish to dive need to have attained the relevant competition dive certificate issued by Swim England/Swim Teachers Association. Without the correct certificate competitors will be required to start in the water. Please upload your certificates on Horse-Events and bring a paper copy with you
- Public swimming pools use chemicals to maintain a safe swimming environment, if your child has an allergy to pool chemicals, please do not let them swim
- **No** photography in or around the swimming pool

RUN

- All runs will be a mass/ group start of no more than 12
- No pacing allowed
- Inhalers cannot be carried and used whilst running

RESULTS, ROSETTES/MEDALS, PRIZEGIVING

- Result will be available on [ponyclubresults](#)
- Rosettes/Medals to the first 6 individuals in each class
- Rosettes/Medals to first 3 individuals in each phase of each class
- Team rosettes/medals will be awarded to first 6 teams in classes 1- 4
