

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
3. The event will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2019 and it is the responsibility of the competitors to make sure that they understand and adhere to the rules. The competition is only open to Pony Club Branch and Centre members.
4. Please ensure that riding hats meet the current Pony Club standard, and are properly tagged with the Aquamarine hat tag.
5. All team managers **MUST** declare their teams 30 minutes prior to the start of the class. Failure to declare will automatically eliminate the team
6. **STRICTLY ONLY TWO** teams allowed into the practice area at any one time and they must be supervised.
7. Strictly **NO** mucking out onto the car park, please use poo pickers provided for horse walks/warm up areas.
8. Ages at 1st January 2019
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class.
10. The welfare of the horse/pony is the responsibility of the owner/rider, whether mounted or unmounted, and should be fit for the competition.
11. **NO** prams/pushchairs, wheelchairs or mobility vehicles allowed in any warm up area or horse walks.
12. No refunds will be made after the closing date.
13. No substitutions after teams have been declared.
14. **The event venue stipulates all horses/ponies entering the event site must comply with the BEF Vaccination guidelines (issued Feb-19) – passports must accompany all horses/ponies and spot checks will be undertaken:**
 1. 1st Primary injection followed within 21 to 92 days by 2nd Primary injection
 2. 1st Booster injection which follows within 150 to 215 days of the 2nd Primary Injection
 3. Subsequent Boosters, which follow no less than 1 year after the previous booster**As a minimum requirement horses/ponies must have had the primary vaccinations (1st & 2nd injections) and in addition following any vaccinations there must be clear 7 days before attending the event**

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD

ALL CLASSES IN ALL RINGS WILL RUN AS A SINGLE PHASE

Competitors will jump the whole course, unless they are eliminated. Second part of the course will be timed and approx 5cm higher, faults to be accumulated over both sections.

Arena start times are provisionally 9.00am, this may change depending on entries but will be published on Thursday 2nd May with the start lists.

RING 1, 2 & 3 ENTRY FEES PER CLASS – PER COMPETITOR

Rufford Hunt Pony Club members £10 plus £1 booking fee
Others £12 plus £1 booking fee

RING 1:

Each branch to provide an arena party whilst their team is jumping

Class 1 70cm Team & Individual Competition

Class 2 80cm Team & Individual Competition

RING 2:

Each branch to provide an arena party whilst their team is jumping

Class 3 Novice. 90cm Team & Individual Competition

Class 4 Intermediate 1m Team & Individual Competition

Class 5 Small Open 1.05cm Team & Individual Competition

Class 6 Open 110cm Team & Individual Competition

RING 3:

ALL CLASSES FOR COMPETITORS 10 YEARS & UNDER

Horse/Rider combinations entered in Classes 7, 8, 9 & 10 CAN NOT enter Classes 2 to 6 and may only jump in 2 sequential height classes (i.e. 30cm & 40cm / 40cm & 50cm / 50cm & 60cm / 60cm & 70cm)

The following classes are aimed at riders who are inexperienced at jumping and designed to encourage riders to start competing.

Each branch to provide an arena party whilst their team is jumping

All competitors in classes 7 & 8 will receive a rosette

Class 7 30cm Team & Individual Competition

Class to be sectioned a) Lead Rein, b) Assisted but not lead – all competitors must be assisted by 1 adult in the arena

Class 8 40cm Team & Individual Competition

Class to be sectioned a) Lead Rein, b) Assisted but not lead – all competitors must be assisted by 1 adult in the arena

Class 9 50cm Team & Individual Competition

Class 10 60cm Team & Individual Competition

For Classes 9 & 10 Entrants MUST NOT be assisted in any way, either from inside or outside of the Arena as this could lead to elimination.

- The Judges' decisions are final in ALL arenas.
- ALL CLASSES – where possible we will combine individuals into mixed teams unless requested as individuals only in the entry special requests.
- Entries may be limited.
- Each team to consist of 3 or 4 members. Best 3 scores to count.
- No horse or pony may jump more than once in any class though riders may compete on 2 different horses/ponies in any 1 class.
- A competitor/horse combination may compete in 3 height classes BUT only once in each class except for Ring 3 where combinations can only compete in 2 height classes.
- Rosettes to 6th place (team & individual)
