- Entries will be received on a first come, first served basis.
- Horses and ponies shall be over 4 years old.
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes at any given time.
- Rosettes, according to entries.
- Objections must be submitted in writing with a £25 deposit, within 30 minutes of the completion of the class.

- Class 1 50cm - Christmas Fancy Dress (to be competed in) Best Fancy Dress will be awarded. 1a Assisted, 1b Non-Assisted. Entry £12
- Class 2 60cm - Christmas Cracker Pairs Relay. Best fancy Dress will be awarded. Entry £25 per pair
- Class 3 60cm Individual Christmas pudding stakes - Best Fancy Dress will be awarded Entry £14
- Class 4 70cm – Christmas Jumper and Tinsel – Best Jumper and Tinsel will be awarded. Entry £14
- Class 5 80cm – The Debut Spring Festival Qualifier. Entry £15 (includes Spring Festival Fee). Individual Qualifying Class.
- Class 6 90cm - The PC Challenge Spring Festival Qualifier. Entry £15 (includes Spring Festival Fee). Individual Qualifying Class.
- Class 7 100/105cm – No Qualifier because there is direct entry to the Open Grand Prix Area Competition. Entry £14

Class 5 & 6 are individual Qualifying Classes for Spring Qualifier £14. The event will be run under the Spring Qualifier 2022 Rules, which can be found on The Pony Club website. There are no qualifying cards this year, an online declaration must be completed and returned to the Pony Club Office.

Class 1 a&b, Class 2 and Class 3 will be timed overall.

Classes 4,5,6&7 will be run as a single-phase competition; the second part of the course is against the clock.

ENTRY FEE: Horse Events - £1.45 non-refundable booking fee per entry. In the event of the abandonment of the event, £5 per entry will be retained by the organising branch to contribute to administration and cancellation costs

Pony Club eligibility rules for Spring Festival - Full Rules available on the PCUK website

DEBUT ELIGIBILITY

Combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- Represented their Branch/Centre at PC100 (Intermediate) or above at Summer Area Qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships
- Been placed 1st – 3rd as INDIVIDUAL in the PC90 (Novice) or above Pony Club Show Jumping Championships
- **Rider** is NOT eligible if they have:
- Previously competed at the Winter Series Open Grand Prix Championships; or • The Pony Club Show Jumping Final at Hickstead

PC CHALLENGE ELIGIBILITY

- **Combination** of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:
- Represented their Branch/Centre at PC110 (Open) Summer Area Qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships (this does not include any other classes held in conjunction with the Area Qualifier)

Combination of horse/pony and rider CAN qualify for both the Debut Championships and PC Challenge Championships in the same year but CANNOT also qualify for the Open Grand Prix Final.
