Entries via Horse Events and close September 15th

Class 1	Jumping 20cm – clear round then a timed round
Class 2	Jumping 40cm – clear round then a timed round
Class 3	Pairs jumping 40cm
Class 4	Accumulator within one minute
Class 5	Chase me Charlie – split into age groups
Class 6	Freestyle dressage within two minutes – bring your own music (music optional)

Competitors can use a hobby horse or a crafty pony in all classes

- ➤ Individual rosettes to 6th place in each class. A non-place rosette to each child who has not been placed during the afternoon.
- ➤ Entry fees per class Non PC members £10, PC members £8, ST members £6
- > Refreshments available.
- > Requests for reasonable adjustments to be made upon entry
- > Bring a folding chair for spectating

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The event will be run under Pony Club Rules 2025.
- 2. No outside assistance is allowed
- 3. Entries will be limited and taken on a first come basis.
- 4. The organisers reserve the right to amend the times of classes or cancel classes according to entries. If by close of entries there are less than 6 entries the class will not run.
- 5. Riding hats with a pink tag can be worn. Trousers must not be loose fitting around the legs
- 6. Non PC members must have their own insurance cover
- 7. The judge's decision is final
- 8. No refunds after the closing date
