Competitors may do up to two Dressage and two Show jumping classes. You can be in two teams if you do two dressage tests. The lowest dressage class number will need to line up with the lowest Show Jumping Class number.

Entry fees for all classes, except hobby horse is £10 or £20 for an individual in a team. Entries can be made on-line via booking bee.

Closing date Wednesday 8 May . Times available Friday 10 May on Facebook.

RULES:

- 1. All ponies and horses must be 5 years of age or over
- 2. Hats must comply with the Pony Club Hat Rule 2024 and be tagged and correctly fastened when mounted.
- 3. Teams will consist of 3 or 4 rider and pony combinations.
- 4. Classes will be run under Pony club Dressage/ Show jumping rules 2024.
- 5. The organisers reserve the right to split classes, cancel, alter advertised times, limit entries in classes or refuse entry where necessary.
- 6. Elimination in all classes; riders will be allowed to complete the course time permitting.
- 7. All litter must be gathered up and disposed of properly.
- 8. Dogs to be kept on the lead at all times.
- 9. Classes 6 &7 should do dressage tests from memory, tests can be called for classes 1-5.
- 10. Flu vaccinations Please ensure your horse/ponies flu vaccinations are up to date according to BEF advice and that you bring your passport with you to the competition to be checked.
- 11. If your horse/pony is showing any signs of an infectious disease or is coming from a yard where restrictions are in place please do not attend.
- 12. Competitors must provide their own numbers. Bib numbers are preferred as it makes it easier for the show jumping judges.
