Back in November a few of us had the privilege to gather and present Isabelle Thomson with her Pony Club Cubitt Award for services to the pony club.

The Cubitt Award celebrates 20 years of voluntary service.

Isabelle was our secretary for over 20 years. There wasn't anything that was too much trouble, and her knowledge and dedication were second to none. She also did all the safeguarding, kept tabs on mountains of equipment and organised all the trophies.

Isabelle was presented her award by Irene Whitson who is a previous DC of our club and also our current president.

RESULTS OF RALLY SURVEY

Thank you to everyone who responded to our online rally survey and thanks to Lindsay for running it and providing the following analysis. We had 20 responses from a variety of age groups (representing 40% of our members).

Summary of venue feedback

1. Venue Variety and Accessibility: There is a desire for more venues and a greater variety of locations, with some venues being noted as not easily accessible. Suggestions include considering Sandyflats indoor over the winter and holding rallies at larger competition venues like Morris.

2. Instructor Variety: There is a call for more variety in instructors, particularly at certain venues, to enhance the overall experience.

3. General Positive Feedback: Positive comments include appreciation for the rotation of venues, the mixture of different stables, and the overall range of venues making attendance easier.

Summary of rally satisfaction

1. Rally Scheduling and Planning: Members express a need for more rallies, especially during weekends in winter months, and suggest that knowing rally dates and venues further in advance would help in planning logistics.

2. Targeted Rallies for Different Age Groups: There is a desire for rallies and lessons specifically aimed at young horses and younger members, as well as for older members and those competing at higher levels. Suggestions include TRT method, stable manners, and building resilience for young horses, and more consideration for older members when choosing instructors.

3. Cost and Flexibility Concerns: Some members find the rallies too expensive and inflexible, with issues such as non-refundable cancellations and the difficulty of managing young kids in cold weather. They suggest altering costs based on group sizes and providing more affordable options.

4. Variety and Continuity in Rallies: Members appreciate the variety of rally locations and the ease of the booking system but desire more variety in the types of rallies, such as arena eventing and big cross-country venues. Continuity with instructors is also valued.

5. Positive Feedback on Instructors and Organization: Members praise the well-organized rallies, the range of great coaches, low group numbers, and good venues.

How we have responded to the feedback:

All rallies are now being subsidised by the club as we aim to keep costs as low as possible for members.


Specialist clinics with guest instructors such as dressage with John Cameron. Please note that these clinics will be slightly more expensive but still subsidised.


We have booked more rallies at Sandyflats; there are 2 in March.
