**Open to ALL** (including Schools and Riding Clubs)

**Entry Fees**     £60 per Team – 3 or 4 riders  
                             £15 per Individual

### **Entry Notes**

A horse/pony combination may compete **once in each class** and again in the **following** class.

A horse/pony combination may not compete in more than **2 classes**.

A rider may compete more than once in a class on another horse/pony, but no rider can compete in the same team more than once.

The **best 3 scores** will count towards the Team score.

**ALL TEAM COMPETITORS AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY FOR BOTH TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL PRIZES (but only ride once).**

### **Classes**

#### **Class 1 Teams and Individuals (50cm)**

For combinations of horse/pony and rider that have never been placed 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> at 70cm (2'6") or higher in a showjumping class before 31 January 2022.

#### **Class 2 Teams and Individuals (65cm)**

Combinations of horse/pony and rider that have competed in showjumping classes at 75cm and over are not eligible.

#### **Class 3 Teams and Individuals (75cm)**

Combinations of horse/pony and rider that have competed in showjumping classes at 90cm and over are not eligible.

#### **Class 4 Teams and Individuals (85cm)**

No restrictions

#### **Class 5 Teams and Individuals (95cm)**

No restrictions

## Team and Individual Showjumping Competition

### General Information

All classes are Single Phase. After a rider jumps the first section they automatically go into a second timed section, regardless of their score in the first section, unless they have been eliminated (e.g. 3 refusals or 1 fall).

Any protest regarding eligibility to ride in Classes 1, 2 or 3 **must** be made before the prize giving for the particular class.

Pony Club Showjumping Rules apply.

Hats must comply with current safety standards – PAS015 or EN 1384 with kite mark.

Stirrup control system equipment (interlocking boots/stirrup treads) are not permitted.

Teams should appoint a team manager, who will be responsible for ensuring teams are ready to ride at their allocated time.

### Entries

Entries should be made by the Team Manager or Individual rider via EQUO only. All **TEAM** entries on EQUO **MUST** have the additional team members details entered in the **ENTRANT NOTES** section of the entry form.

### ENTRIES CLOSE ON 31 January 2022

Entries may close early in the event of over subscription. Entries will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date.

Payment must be made at time of entry on EQUO.

### Warm Up

Ring stewards will move each team into the warm up area as soon as it is possible to do so.

### Start Times

Approximate start times and numbers will be available from **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2022 on the Strathearn Pony Club website and on EQUO.**

### Numbers

Riders must provide their own number bib and print out their own numbers.

### Medical Cover

Medical cover will be provided.

### Prize giving

An **unmounted** prize giving will take place in the main arena after each class has finished.

Rosettes will be awarded to the first 6 Teams in each class.

Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th to the best Individuals in each class.
