- 4. Correct dress MUST be worn i.e Hacking Jackets and tie. It is strongly recommended that body protectors should be worn.
- 5. Correct footwear MUST be worn.
- 6. Dogs MUST be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES.
- 7. Entries may be limited.
- 8. Any objections with £10 to the secretary. Deposit to be forfeited if objection over rules.
