| 9 Beanies | Bean Bags | 500m | 45cm | Under 8 years on the day (this class may be spilt boy / girls if numbers permit) |
| 10 Beanies Bi. | Bean Bags | 500m | NO RIDE | Under 8 years on the day |
| 11.Mixed U12 Bi. | 7m Turning | 1000m | NO RIDE | Under 12 and Min of 8 years on the day |

Medals to phase winners.

Drop down rides available for all classes INCLUDING beanies who can opt to ride a "poles on the ground course"

Shooting will take place in the Ashford (Indoor) arena, running will be held in the fields, riding will take place in both the Ashford (Indoor) arena and the covered school. Bean bagging to take place in the Ashford arena seating area.

Please note: **No dogs** allowed.

Entry Fees: £28 per competitor for classes 1-8, (£26 for 2nd and subsequent family members). Class 9 (Beanies) £22 per competitor. Class 10 & 11 (Biathlon) £15 per competitor.

- **Objections:** To be raised by Team Managers only and within 20 mins of each phase results being published
- **Shooting:** Please familiarise yourself with the 2024 rules for Shooting, specifically Gun handling, and safety flag requirements

- **Show Jumping:** Competitors may elect to drop down a height (**but will incur 400 penalties**).

This is a friendly event and we will not eliminate for outside assistance (shouting encouragement and directions from the side) in any class but it will incur 200 penalties in all classes (see below for Beanies rule).

Beanies will incur 200 penalties for lead rein or running in front of or alongside pony, or 100 penalties for providing child with direction and vocal support from the side.

- **Hat Tag:** Please note hat standards. All competitors will need to have a 2024 hat tag. To avoid delays on the day, please ensure your hat is already tagged by your DC prior to the event.

TEAM MANAGERS Indicate team members clearly on the entry form. If no team is nominated, the Organisers will, if numbers permit, select team members. No alterations will be allowed. The Organisers reserve the right to alter teams on the day if necessary due to last-minute withdrawals. This will be done before scores have been posted. Please also make all competitors/parents aware of the Rules of the competition. - Mark on entry form if competitor is sharing gun, shoots with left hand, together with run score – **DUE TO THE VERY TIGHT TIMINGS FOR THESE EVENTS CHANGES CANNOT BE MADE ON THE DAY.**
