

<u>CAMP</u> EQUIPMENT, CLOTHING ETC.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT EVERYTHING IS LABELLED AS ITEMS CAN GET LOST OR LEFT BEHIND

The following list is <u>for guidance only.</u> Remember to bring everything you think you or your pony /horse will need during your stay at camp. The weather can be very changeable, please have all eventualities covered!

Pony's Vaccination Certificate and Passport to check in your pony (up-to-date)

In order to ensure riders are wearing the most up to date riding hats, please note that from 1st January 2023, the following hat standards will no longer be accepted, due to the age of hats made to these standards:

- 1. PAS O15 1998
- 2. SNELL 2001

- Jodhpurs
- Sweatshirts/Polo/t-shirts (to be worn when riding in addition to t-shirt provided.
- White shirt, pony club tie, beige/cream jodhpurs for last day competition.
- Clothes and suitable footwear for evening games
- Overalls/change of clothes for yard work
- Wellington boots for yard work
- Riding boots, chaps, spurs if worn
- Body Protector (see Body Protector Rules 2024)
- Wet weather gear
- Warm jumpers
- Sensible shoes to wear in the barn covered toes, study soles

Horse/Pony

- Tack clean and in safe condition (please check stitching etc. in good repair)
 INSURED UNDER YOUR OWN POLICY
- Rugs
- 1 x lead rope
- 1 x headcollar
- Feed bucket/bowl
- 2 or 3 hay nets (hay provided for camp but not the journey home
- Hard feed marked in bins or bags with clear instructions! Please note even ponies not usually fed will need something.
- 2 water buckets
- Grooming kit hoof pick, solid hoof oil and brush, dandy brush, curry comb, body brush, sponge, water brush, stable rubber (cloth), plaiting bands, all in a bag or box named
- Saddle soap, sponges, rags, all in a named bag.
- Wheelbarrow, stable fork stiff broom, shovel
- Insect repellent for ponies and for humans
- NB: No sharp knives (for cutting carrots etc)

Stable Management/Theory

- 2 x stable bandages 2 x gamgee for stable management
- Pencil and notebook



Sundries

- Toiletries
- Sun cream and hat
- Torch
- Shoe cleaning kit
- Plate, bowl, knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon, mug, tea towel all in a named draw string bag
- A raised camp bed
- two crates/bread trays that will fit under the bed
- Pillows
- Duvet/sleeping bag
- Bag for dirty washing
- Towels, soap, shower gel and shampoo

<u>PLEASE</u> make sure you have everything you and your pony will need for the duration of camp and that is **all clearly labelled.** Make sure you have discussed any individual worries or requests beforehand with the organiser so that she can do her best to help you, rather than 'bombard' her with requests on what will be a hectic, arrival.

Mobile Phones: We will operate a strict NO MOBILE PHONES policy. In case of emergency there will be a mobile phone with the organisers which can be used.
