Rally Information:

All rallies to be booked and paid for via Horse-Events https://www.horse-events.co.uk/ponyclub-rallies/?pcbc=534f7310-c56c-e911-a9a5-00224800c3e8 Places are limited on some rallies, and we may ask members to only book in one pony. If the rally you wish to come to is full, please contact the rally organiser to go on a wait list (some rallies may have a wait list on Horse-Events). Please let us know if you wish to cancel. Refunds are given if you have a vet/doctor's certificate or if your place is filled from a wait list. If you withdraw via Horse-Events 2 weeks or more before the rally date you will be refunded. Unless stated above, rally times will be emailed to you.

Rally Dress Code: You may wear either a jacket (hacking or black/navy) with a shirt and PC tie or a WKS Red polo shirt or sweatshirt. Dark coloured hat silk (no pom-poms), beige or dark coloured jodhpurs. Plain tack, saddlecloth/numnah – white, black, brown, navy. Hats- PAS015:1998 and Snell E2001 are no longer accepted. Please have your hat checked and tagged at your next rally. Base layer

skins may be worn at cross country & games rallies (Please remember body protectors BETA 2018 level 3- blue/black are compulsory for all XC) Also remember your hairnet and gloves & no earrings. If you need a copy of our Dress Code leaflet, please ask Mrs Giddings.

Parents – Please remember not to encourage, reprimand, or instruct your children whilst they are under instruction at a rally. If you have any concerns, please speak to the rally organiser. Thank you.

WORKING RALLIES WITH STABLE MANAGEMENT /BADGES

Members are in small groups with 45mins/1hr riding and 45mins/1hr stable management working towards a test or achievement badge. Suitable for all members from lead rein up.

FRIDAY NIGHT FUN GAMES RALLIES

These popular rallies are something to look forward to after school on a Friday! A fun rally of non-competitive mounted games suitable for all members from lead rein up.

Show Jumping

There are Pony Club show jumping championships from 70cm upwards. The Regional Championships will have competitions at 70cm and 80cm and the PC Championships will have classes at 90m, 1m and 1.10m. Qualification for all classes will be held at the Area competition at Hickstead on 30th June. Anyone wishing to go forward for selection to represent the branch should email katetamblyn@btinternet.com. The SJ Area selection rally on **9th June** is essential for anyone wanting to go to Area for the first time, or who is competing on a different pony or at a different height to at previous Area competitions. All combinations must be experienced and confident at the height at which they wish to compete. See the 'Competitions' notes below for details on conditions of entry and the team selection policy. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have. The Area team training at Felbridge on **16th June** is by invitation only, for those selected for Area.

Dressage

Our Dressage rallies on **4th May** and **19th May** are test & re-test for Area selection if you wish to be considered for the Area competition on **23rd June** at Felbridge. Please choose your test when booking in. You will ride and be marked on your chosen test, discuss it with the judge and then ride the test again. Eventing

Upcoming rallies – **Sun 17th March** -'Introduction to XC' rally at Walton on the Hill. 40-60cm. 9am start. Ideal first cross-country rally, come and give it a try. **Weds 10 April** - 'All about eventing' half-day rally at Lodge Farm. A fun and educational rally suitable for everyone, especially geared to eventing novices. Fences from 50cm to 90cm. 10am start, with D Staples & S Rook. Practise a dressage test with instruction, have a showjumping lesson in a small group then head out onto the cross-country course with an instructor (in a small group). There will also be a briefing and Q&A for members and parents who are new to eventing, explaining everything you need to know e.g. how to prepare, equipment for horse and rider, the format of the day, scoring, safety and much more with an opportunity for all attendees to earn their Eventing badge. Bring a packed lunch for you and your pony. **Sat 25 May** XC rally at Bonfleur with S Rook. 50-80cm. From 10am. A particularly good practice opportunity for anyone heading to the PC70 Regional Qualifier on 16th June.

What to wear

Body protectors to BETA Level 3 2018(blue/black tag) are compulsory for all cross-country events and rallies. Hats: For all XC, competitions, training & rallies, a jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn. All hats must meet PC hat requirements and be tagged. Sweatshirts/skins may be worn at XC rallies. When representing your branch in a team or as an individual, riders should wear a Pony Club red sweatshirt or red XC skin and a red hat silk.

Area/Regional competitions

The Area eventing qualifier (for PC80, PC90, PC100, Chairman's Cup and PC110) will be at Blindley Heath Nr Lingfield RH7 6JL on 26th (PC80) & 27th (all others) May. Timing of the classes is not yet known. Anyone wishing to be considered to represent WKS should contact Sara Crane ASAP. All combinations will need to have solid eventing competition experience at their selected height, with at least two completions, and have attended three PC rallies in the past year, including one eventing rally. Sara is happy to answer any questions you may have and discuss options. Those qualifying at PC80 at Area (and PC70 Regional Qualifier on 16 June) will progress to the Regional Championships 24-26 Aug at Rectory Farm GL7 7JW; those qualifying at PC90-PC110 will head to PC Championships at Offchurch Bury, 15-17 Aug. Whip rule: For Show Jumping and Cross Country a padded whip must be used, full details of the type of whip can be found in the relevant Rulebook.

SUMMER CAMPS

Here are the dates for camps. You reserve your camp place and pay a deposit via Horse-Events. There will be a camp meeting on 3rd July at Judd Wood Farm at 6pm for all campers and their parent/carer. SENIOR RESIDENTIAL CAMP – Monday 22nd July – Friday 26th July 2024 - £300 Our Senior camp for members 12 years and over is at Judd Wood Farm, Tonbridge TN11 8AB

JUNIOR CAMP – Monday 29th July– Thursday 1st August 2024 - £200 Junior camp is also at Judd Wood Farm and is great fun for members 8 – 11 years old (who are competent at walk and trot off the leading rein in an open field with other ponies).
