Classes

<u>Class 1</u> :	Beanies – 5 to 7 years mixed teams. Bean bag throw; Run 500m; Swim 2 mins (flotation aids may be used – 50 point penalty) Cross country ride height 40cm approx. – (may be led or assisted – 50 penalties) Sec A: Girls Sec B: Boys
<u>Class 2:</u>	Tadpoles – 9 years and under mixed teams. Shoot, 2 handed static targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins; Cross country ride height 60cm approx. Sec A: Girls Sec B: Boys
<u>Class 3</u> :	Minimus – 11 years and under mixed teams Shoot, 2 handed turning targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins; Cross country ride height 75cm approx. Sec A: Girls Sec B: Boys
<u>Class 4</u> :	Juniors - 14 years and under mixed teams Shoot, 1 handed turning targets; Run 1500m; Swim 3 mins; Cross country ride height 90cm approx. (75cm course – 500pt penalty) NOTE: The riding phase for Juniors will be held on Monday 21 st April at Tidpit Down Hunter trial. Sec A: Girls Sec B: Boys

Competitors may jump the course below their own height but will incur 500 penalties. Please indicate this on the entry form

<u>Class 5</u>: Beanies triathlon - 7 years and under mixed teams. Bean bag throw; Run 500m; Swim 2 mins (flotation aids may be used – 50 point penalty) Sec A: Girls Sec B: Boys

3.	Rosettes:	According to entries.
4.	Results:	In a team of 4, the best overall 3 scores count Live scoring on the day on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk
	Queries:	Lodged by managers only and within 30 minutes after posting of results and within 10 minutes of final results being posted. PLEASE NOTE: COMPLAINTS TO BE MADE BY TEAM MANAGERS ONLY
5.	Timings:	To be found on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk no later than Friday 11th April
6.	Shooting:	All guns are to be kept in a locked car boot other than at the shooting centre at time of shoot. Guns must remain boxed until the range steward gives the order to 'unbox' at the start of the detail and must be boxed again before the competitor leaves the firing point.
7	D'1'	Eye protection must be worn when shooting and long trousers are required.
/.	Riding:	All competitors to print own numbers and provide bibs
		All riding hats to be tagged with a pink tag to comply with the 2025 hat rules. Body protector Beta 2018 level 3 (blue and black label).
		Spurs may only be worn by riders who have achieved the C+ riding test or the spurs achievement badge.

8. Dogs: Please <u>**DO NOT**</u> bring dogs onto the Estate.
