Please don't arrive before 9am.

Morning Rides 9.30am - 12.30pm (Very Minis start at 10.30am)

Afternoon Rides 1.30pm - 4.30pm (Very Minis finish at 3.30pm)

Do bring a picnic lunch and stay or arrive early for the afternoon session.  
There will be a toilet in the parking field.

**PLEASE BE READY AND MOUNTED** ready to start promptly at the first activity of the session. Meet coaches at your first activity.

PLEASE PUT A RED RIBBON ON PONIES WHICH KICK & A GREEN RIBBON ON YOUNG PONIES.

#### **MEMBERS dress code**

Hats must be worn and securely fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must have pink hat tags.

Back Protectors are essential for fixed solid fences cross country – **MUST BE LEVEL 3 BETA 2018 standard. 2009 is NO LONGER ALLOWED.**

Plain black, navy, brown hat cover  
Beige jodhpurs

White shirt and official PC Tie or branch polo t-shirt  
Branch sweatshirt  
Long or short riding boots- plain black or brown half chaps may be  
Long hair must be in hairnets  
No jewellery (necklaces, bracelets, rings)- stud earrings must be taped over.

## PONIES

Please make sure that your pony is clean and well turned out  
Please don't leave ponies unattended tied to outside of trailers/lorries  
Please bring hay for your pony, with water and a bucket

## TACK

A saddle and complete bridle- correct grass reins if needed (see website for guidance)  
Plain single colour numnah or branch numnah  
A head collar with at least 6' rope attached  
A complete grooming kit  
Tack cleaning materials

Whilst we always encourage children to clean and care for their own tack, it has been noted at previous camps that some items had been put together incorrectly. Please do check. Also, stirrup leathers and irons need to be the correct length and width for your child.

If you are unsure, just ask.

## PARENTS

The field gate must be closed at all times to prevent a pony from escaping onto the road.

Please be mindful of ponies when driving in and out, and please park sensibly in lines facing the hedge so you can leave easily.

Please do watch your children riding but please make sure that you **do not interfere with the lesson. Let your children concentrate on what the coach is teaching them.**

A reminder that you are responsible for the behaviour, conduct and safety of ALL children they bring to Camp who are not riding.

Must not allow children to wander unsupervised around farm.

Please take your rubbish home and clear all horse droppings from your parking area. Bring something to pick it up with please, and put in your trailer to take home.
