

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A horse/pony may compete only once in each individual class. In pairs they may compete more than once with different partners.
2. Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old.
3. Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted manufactured to one of the following standards:-
BSI Kitemark and CE and either PAS015:1998, 2010, or 2011
BS EN 1384:1997, EN 1384:1996.
OR Australian certified and CE and either AS/NZS 3838 1998, or 2003.
OR Snell E2001 with CE and the official Snell number.

A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn when riding cross country over fences 80cm and above. It is also strongly recommended over lower fences.

Hats must be fitted with a pony club tag and/or be subject to checks on the day.
4. An effective body protector must be worn for the cross-country.
5. In the case of over-subscription, entries received first will have precedence.
6. The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes
7. Awards may be varied according to entries.
8. Entry money will be refunded for withdrawals made before the closing date.
9. Judges decision is final. Any objections in writing with £10 deposit will be accepted according to Pony Club Eventing Rules.

Class 3 Pairs

Approx 60cm (2'0") level 1 - Optimum speed 300m/min

Class 4 Individual

Approx 60cm (2'0") level 1 - Optimum speed 300m/min

Class 5 Pairs

Approx 75cm (2'6") level 2 - Optimum speed 325m/min

Class 6 Individual

Approx 75cm (2'6") level 2 - Optimum speed 325m/min

Class 7 Individual

Approx 90cm (3'0") level 3 - Optimum speed 350m/min

1 st refusal at a fence.....	10 penalties
2 nd refusal at same fence.....	20 penalties
3 rd refusal at same fence.....	Elimination
Fence knocked down.....	5 penalties
Error of course.....	Elimination
1 st fall of rider.....	30 penalties
2 nd fall of rider.....	Elimination
Fall of horse/pony.....	Elimination
Circling between fences will not be penalised	

The winning places will be decided by the least jumping penalties but in the event of a tie the nearest to the optimum time will decide.

The courses will have an optimum time based on speeds given on page 2.

Optimum time will be displayed on day.

Cross country colours may be worn.

HAT TAGGING: PLEASE BRING YOUR HAT when you collect your number for the tag to be checked.

Refreshments will be available on the day from the onsite café.
