

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The event will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2018. Rules and dressage tests can be downloaded or purchased from The Pony Club website www.pcupk.org Rider's dress and horse's/pony's saddlery must conform with the rules.
- 2 Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old and may not compete more than once.
- 3 Competitors must wear a protective helmet with cover at all times when mounted, manufactured to one of the following standards:
 - PAS 015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark
 - VG1 with BSI Kitemark
 - Snell E2001 with official Snell label and number
 - ASTM-F1163 2004a with SE1 mark
 - AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwardsA jockey skull-cap must be worn for cross-country riding over fences 0.80m or higher and is also strongly recommended for cross-country riding over lower fences. Hats must be fitted with a PC, BE or BRC aquamarine tag and will be checked. For cross-country an effective body protector meeting BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) must be worn. In addition an air jacket may be worn. The wearing of a medical armband is advised if the rider is not accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 4 Stopwatches are allowed to be worn at PC90, PC100 and PC110 levels.
- 5 Competitors will be asked to leave the course after elimination due to third refusal, run out or circle at the same fence or fourth refusal etc on the course overall. Black flag alternatives will be available.
- 6 Excessive use of spurs, whip etc and use of offensive language by competitors or supporters will be penalised.
- 7 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class or award.

LEGAL LIABILITY Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their occupants and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
