

DIRECTIONS TO BERROW SANDS FOR THE BEACH RIDE

M5 south to Junction 22

B43140 to Burnham on Sea

B3139 to Berrow

Follow the signs to Berrow and Brean, along the Coast Road.

Turn left (just after Unity Farm on the right) – the sign says “Welcome to Berrow Beach” and has a parking sign on the top – Berrow Beach Parking. It is a wide entrance with a kiosk and barriers (should be up) and you drive down the track (Sundowner Beach Bar on your right – toilets there), onto the beach. We try and park on the left-hand side.

If you miss the entrance, don't panic there is a roundabout just up the road where you can turn round.

Please be mindful that there will be others using the beach on the day – we will do our best to park together, but this may not be possible.

The plan is to arrive at 11:00, ride on the beach and then return to the vehicles for lunch (don't forget to bring!) and then have another ride out, before driving home.

Although we would all envisage a great canter (no galloping allowed!!) on the beach, this is only possible if there are no people/dogs about, so please remember this. You must WALK past any other beach users, especially dogs. If people have put their dogs on leads for us to pass – please make sure you all say thank you.

NO ONE IS ALLOWED NEAR THE WATERS EDGE (unless you are told you may) – **THERE ARE MANY BOGGY AREAS AND WE MUST KEEP WELL AWAY.** We keep towards the top of the beach for that reason. If the tide is in enough, then we may get a chance to go in the sea.

The beach is very open – please make sure you are able to control your pony in a wide open space that will be windy!!

Wrap up warm (with layers) – don't worry about PC clothing, just making sure you have the correct hat and boots, and a windproof coat.

I don't think there is a charge for parking, but please be prepared to pay if this has changed.
