



PONY CLUB AREA 12 CHAMPIONSHIPS SHOW JUMPING 2024



SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP – BERKSHIRE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE SUNDAY 27TH OCTOBER 2024

The Championships are designed to encourage younger or less experienced Area 12 Pony Club members to compete in Team Competitions.

For Show Jumping, there are classes at four heights – 40cms, 50cms, 60cms and 70cms. The 40 and 50cms heights are restricted to competitors who are 12 years and under.

The emphasis is on the Team Competitions. For those Branches and Centres that do not have three or four qualified competitors, the organisers will create mixed teams which will compete on an equal basis to single Branch/Centre teams.

Each class will award rosettes for the 1st to 6th Teams and 1st to 6th Individuals (who may be from a Team or an individual entry). The winning team members will each receive a sash or prize, as will the winning individual.

Qualification Cards will be given to DCs for distribution to qualifying Branch/Centre members, detailing a link to a Google Docs Registration Form – <https://forms.gle/VGqfgArW3BtFMtPg9>

It is the responsibility of the DCs to satisfy themselves that their member has qualified at an event, before awarding the Qualification Card. Qualification is for the rider and pony/horse combination for all classes.

Each qualifier will be required to complete the simple Google Docs Registration Form noted above and nearer to the event, they will receive an e-mail with the Schedule and link to the Entry Form. OBHS will liaise with DCs/Team Managers to ensure all qualified members are registered and so have a chance of entering as a Team Member or an Individual.

In line with other Pony Club competitions, members will be able to qualify and compete at 2 adjacent heights. **Please note:** Team members can each qualify at a different event – there is no requirement for a 'Team' qualification.

ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted directly from individuals on HorseMonkey. DCs will be sent details of all those entered and asked for Team information.

SHOW JUMPING - TEAMS & INDIVIDUALS

- 40cms class only may be led or assisted.
- Competitors must report to the Steward and Tack Check at least 15 minutes prior to their start time

- The competition will be over two rounds with some fences in the second round approximately 5cms higher than the first round. The second round will be single phase. The second round may be in a different ring.
- The scores from the first round will be added to the scores of the second round. If equality of faults, the times from the second round single phase will be used.
- In the event that there is still a tie, there will be a jump off against the clock by one nominated rider from each tying Team and Individual competitors.
- Teams eliminated in the 1st round will not be able to jump in the 2nd round but non-eliminated Team Members will be able to compete in the 2nd round as Individuals.

QUALIFICATION

- All qualifiers from the Regional Competitions/Interbranch at Middlegrove will automatically qualify at their appropriate height in the Area 12 Championships.
- Alternatively, to qualify for the Championships, the pony and horse/rider combination must have achieved a double clear round at a Pony Club show at either 40, 50, 60 or 70cms.
- Qualification events are those run by a PC Branch but do not have to be in Area 12.
- The Qualification Period is 1st October 2023 to end September 2024 for each class.

ELIGIBILITY - ALL LEVELS

- The pony and horse/rider combination must not have been placed at any Show Jumping competition at a height more than 10cms above their Championship class height. E.g. they can enter the 60cm and 70cm as long as they have not been placed above 70cm. If they enter the 70cm only, they cannot have been placed above 80cm.
