**Please take note of the new Hat and Body Protector standards below**

### **HAT STANDARDS**

All hats must be checked and tagged; members will not be allowed to compete without a tagged hat. Hats must have the CE mark and a quality symbol, either BSI Kite mark, the SAI Global symbol or the official Snell label with number.

*PAS 015 2011 with BSI Kite mark (1998 no longer acceptable)*

*Snell E2016 **onwards** with the official Snell label and number*

*AS/NZS 3838 2006 **onward** (2003 no longer acceptable)*

*VG1 with BSI Kitemark*

*ASTM-F1163 2004a **onwards** with SEI mark*

**Please come and see me (Cathy) at your first event to have your hat checked and tagged.**

### **BODY PROTECTORS**

Though Body protectors are not compulsory at Pony Club, except for Cross Country & Racing, if worn they must meet **BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue & black label)**

*(BETA 2009 level 3 no longer acceptable)*

### **Mounted rallies (in black)**

These are teaching sessions and the backbone of Pony Club activities. You will be put into groups according to age and ability and are taught by qualified instructors.

**Riders who are 9 & under on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2024 ride from 6.00. – 7.00 p.m.**

**Riders who are 10 & over on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2024 ride from 7.00 – 8.00 p.m.**

The cost for these rallies is just **£7.00** and **MUST** be booked and paid for at least 1 week in advance so we can book the right number of instructors and sort out appropriate rides.

**What to wear;**- PC sweatshirt, shirt, tie, badge, plain jodhpurs, riding boots or jodhpur boots, gloves, and a tagged hat (come to the caravan to have your hat tagged before mounting). If the weather is hot instructors may let you remove your sweatshirts but only if you are wearing a long-sleeved shirt.

At the start of each rally your instructor/or a committee member will mark you out of 5 for the turnout of your tack, pony, and yourself, you also receive 5 points for attending. All these points are added up throughout the season and trophies and rosettes awarded to the members with the most points.

### **Open Clear Round Jumping (in black)**

These are fun evenings where the show jumping and/or the working hunter courses are set out for you to use. Please book a week in advance stating the approximate height you wish to jump, so we can group riders and give out times.

The cost is Members **£5.00** per round, Non Members **£7.00** per round.

Appropriate riding gear **must** be worn.

**Gymkhanas (in green)** The schedules are on your programme. Correct showing gear, i.e., jackets, must be worn for competition (except for games when you can wear your sweatshirts).

The cost for Members is £5.00 per class plus a £3.00 toilet charge per family.

You may enter further classes on the day for £7.00 per class.

The cost for Non Members is £8.00 per class plus a £3.00 toilet charge per family.

You may enter further classes on the day for £10.00 per class.

**Combined Training (in green)** These are competitions involving a dressage test and a round of show jumping. It is not a training rally. The schedules for these are with your programme. Competitors may do the dressage part only but NOT just the show jumping. Entries and payments must be made at least 1 week before the competition. Dressage tests are available from the caravan or on the main PC web site.

**Please ask me or a committee member if you are unsure about this competition.**

**Area Competitions (in red)** These are team competitions in various disciplines. If you wish to be in a team, please contact the Branch team organisers at the front of your programme who will be able to give you more details. Team members will be asked to pay £10.00 towards the entry price.

**Please note to take part in Area Competitions members MUST attend a minimum of 3 working rallies since 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023 (camp counts as one rally).**

**Note this rule;-** For ALL competitions at Area Level and above a **VALID passport & vaccination record** MUST accompany the horse/pony to the event & must be available for inspection throughout the event.

### **Non-Branch Events (in blue)**

These are lists of local shows and other branch events that may be of interest to you. Entries are to be done individually.

At all events **CORRECT RIDING BOOTS & HATS (CORRECTLY FASTENED) MUST BE WORN WHEN MOUNTED.** ALL HATS MUST BE TO APPROVED STANDARDS. Hat checks will continue to be made. Correct showing gear must be worn in competitions.

Neither the Pony Club, nor any person on its behalf, shall be held responsible for any accidents, to competitors or their horses and ponies.

**Lead Rein Rule** Members who are 7 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024 are lead rein riders and eligible for lead rein points at all events. Depending on the standard of the riding of a member they may ride at a rally off the lead rein if the instructor deems it appropriate. At competitions, gymkhanas & combined training, if a 7 & under rider & pony combination is declared off lead rein, they must continue off lead rein for the rest of the season and will gain 12 & under points, except for non-competitive classes. Members may declare one pony off lead rein and another pony on lead rein if appropriate.

**Points** are totalled from Gymkhanas and trophies given out at end of season prize-giving (rosettes for Reserve Champion and Champion). Separate points are awarded for Combined Training and Rallies. **Please ensure you return all trophies for the Dots Cup Day and Prize Giving in plenty of time.** All trophies should have labels on the bottom depicting to which cup day they belong.

**No horses or ponies under the age of 4 years may take part in any pony club activity.**

Neither the Pony Club, nor any person on its behalf, shall be held responsible for any accidents at rallies, gymkhanas, or at any other meetings or activities, to members or their horses or ponies.

**Please note there will be no hot refreshments at mid-week events, but we will be running a tuck shop from the caravan.**
