## *Perpetual Trophy awards*

**Awarded to the member gaining the most points over the two days of the show:**

- ❖ Stan Hill Memorial Cups to the Senior and Junior member;
- ❖ Rookery Jasper Cup to the Minimus member;
- ❖ May Rose Snow Queen Cup to the Novice member; and
- ❖ A J L Connell Cup to the Leading Rein member;

**To qualify, members MUST have competed in at least one of the Saturday classes. Points are awarded for 3 classes on Saturday and 3 classes on Sunday. Points are awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> places.**

**The points trophies will be awarded immediately after Class 36**

## *Age groups for 2024*

Senior – born in or before 2010

Junior – born in 2011, 2012, or 2013

Minimus – born in or after 2014

Novice – Senior/Junior members who feel they cannot jump the height of their class on Saturday

## Saturday 15 June all classes £5 per class

*Horses/ponies must be plaited for all Saturday classes. Class times will not clash, you can enter all 3 classes if you choose to. Heights of jumps will be handicapped if necessary depending on the entries in the class)*

### RING ONE – PONY CLUB PONY – 9AM START

Competitors will be judged individually in this class. Out of the 100 marks available for the class, up to 30 marks will be awarded for turnout. Each member will be asked to do a show, jump a jump and negotiate a variety of hazards. To be judged on standard of turn out, ridden show, manners, and suitability. Conformation of horse/pony will not be judged. The height of the fences will be handicapped to ensure competitors are jumping a height they are comfortable at.

A rosette will be issued for the Best Turned Out Pony & Rider in each class Kindly sponsored by **Hawk Group Ltd**. Seniors/Juniors are expected to turn out their pony themselves. Minimus/Lead Reins may have assistance.

# SUMMER SHOW 2024

## *Show Jumping Class rules – Sunday*

### **A7**

All clears in the first round will go into a drawn order jump off over a shortened course against the clock.

#### **Single phase**

The first half of the course is not against the clock, the second half of the course is against the clock, faults count from both halves.

#### **Baton relay**

The first pony/rider combination jump jumps 1-6 of a course, then change over a stick so that the second pony/rider combination jump jumps 7-12 – all against the clock.

#### **Topscore**

There will be several jumps of differing height each worth different scores. You have 1 minute to score as many points as possible. All jumps can be jumped in both directions. Jumps may only be jumped twice. There is one set of start/finish flags.

#### **Jump and Bend**

Riders will negotiate a set of fences and finish with some bending poles/games. This will be judged in style over the jumps and through the bending/games.

#### **Agility**

Take your hound around an obstacle course including tunnel, bending poles etc – all against the clock.

### **Lead rein riders**

Lead rein riders may compete in classes 15, 16, 17, 19. Classes may be split into lead rein and off lead rein depending on entries.

Lead rein competitors must stay on lead rein at all times when mounted and must be led by a responsible person who is suitably dressed.

### **Optimum Time**

A time will be set, based on a steady canter, for the timed section, the rider/pony combination who gets closest to the time with the least faults will be the winner.

1. We will not take late entries at the show unless it is to enter an additional class. Late entries will be accepted on the day at a cost of £3.00 per class above the class fee
2. Ponies must be plaited on the Saturday.
3. Tack & Turnout according to Pony Club rules.
4. Entries to be made via MyRidingLife by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024

5. Lead rein competitors must stay on lead rein at all times when mounted and must be led by a responsible person who is suitable dressed. Lead rein riders are eligible for Classes 5, 9, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19.
6. Tack should be in accordance with Pony Club Rules.
7. Dress: show Jackets, shirt & tie. Hats must be to Pony Club standard and tagged (pink tag) – see Show secretary before you mount if you need your hat tagged. Body protectors (must be BETA 2018 Level 3 Standard (blue and black label)) and martingales / neck straps are not compulsory but highly recommended.
8. All entrants must nominate a helper on the entry form.
9. Pony Club reserves the right to refuse entry, limit entries, amalgamate, amend, cancel or close classes as necessary.
10. TROPHIES MUST BE RETURNED by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2024 and must be engraved and cleaned. Please return to Pippa Webster or Megan Hughes.
11. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
12. Please clear all litter, droppings and hay.
13. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years or over.
14. The parking area for horse boxes/trailers will be very busy during the period of the show. Please ensure that you park sensibly. Motorbikes, mopeds or bicycles may not be ridden on the show ground.
