

Rally/camp dress & etiquette

- Remember Rallies are organised by VOUNTEERS so please be polite and thoughtful, and make yourself known when you arrive.
- You should wear plain coloured jodhpurs, a shirt and Pony Club tie with a LHPC sweatshirt or jacket (NO HOODIES), and a correctly Tagged Hat. Your pony club badge with coloured felt should be pinned to your jacket or sweat shirt. A body protector (BETA 2009 level 3 standard) is compulsory for cross country and recommended for all disciplines.
- In hot weather you can wear a shirt only but your shoulders MUST be covered. Long sleeves are still recommended as they help guard against scrapes and sunburn!
- In wet weather a waterproof coat (no hood) over the normal rally clothes is fine.
- All hats must be checked for standard and then given a tag.
- Black/brown jodhpur boots with a heel (with or without half chaps) or riding boots must be worn. Gloves are advisable. Long hair MUST be tied up neatly above your collar and in a hair net.
- Your pony and your tack should be clean and in good working order.
- If you can't attend a rally/training that you have booked for, please inform the organiser as soon as possible. Unless you give more than 48 hours' notice, you will be charged.
- Please DO NOT be late for rallies, it is very disruptive for the rest of the group.
- For competitions, please look on www.pcuk.org at the rules for the specific sport to make sure that you are wearing the correct clothes.
