10. **Lead Rein Pony** Rider 7 years and under, 12.2 and under. Rosettes to all competitors, special prize for best Tiny Tot under 5

12. **Best Pony Club Pony** – Rider 12 years and under, to include some tasks, e.g. a jump and games. Competitors will be asked to canter individually.

Conditions of Entry

1. Children's age and eligibility to enter classes must be as per the Pony Club Rule - not to have attained their birthday before 1st January in the current year.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Any objections should be submitted to the judge within 10 minutes of the class finishing, together with a £20 deposit.
4. A riding hat conforming to the Pony Club Hat Rule and tagged with a Pony Club Hat Tag must be worn and correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
5. No liability will be accepted by organisers or landowners or anyone acting on their behalf for loss, damage, accident or illness to horse, rider spectator or any other person or property whatsoever.
6. The organisers reserve the right to amend this schedule as they deem necessary.
7. No pony/horse under 4 years old is allowed in any ridden class.
8. Qualified first aider will be in attendance during the show.
9. The organisers advise that all ponies attending are up to date with their equine influenza vaccinations.
10. Passports may be checked by the secretary.

Health & Safety

The organiser of this event has taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of every person and horse/pony present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. Please do not attend if you feel either you or your pony/horse is unwell.
