**CLASSES TO BE RUN UNDER PONY CLUB MOUNTED GAMES RULEBOOK 2026**

There will be two sessions for both classes, one in the morning and one in the afternoon

Rosettes for all and sashes for the winning teams

Tack and turnout rosettes will be awarded to winning teams

First aid will be provided by The Cowpie Show

Hot and cold refreshments will be available on the Showground all day

Dogs on short leads

Competitors and their accompanying adults will receive free entry to The Cowpie Show so you will be able to look around the show when not competing. We will issue passes once your entry has been received.

All horseboxes/trailers need to arrive by 9am with passes displayed prominently in windscreen so that you can be directed on arrival to the reserved mounted games parking area on the Showground. Horseboxes/trailers are expected to stay all day.

Please note that although the mounted games arena will be on the edge of the Showground, there will be a County Show atmosphere so ponies need to be able to cope with this.

Declaration Forms to be handed in on arrival with pony passports.

Each Team is expected to provide two line stewards per team.

Provisional Games are as follows but may be changed if necessary:

### **Morning Session**

1. Bending
2. Two mug
3. Old sock
4. Stepping stones
5. Bottle
6. Two Flag

### **Afternoon Session:**

1. Bending
2. Two mug
3. Old sock
4. Tyre (individually held)
5. Ball and cone
6. Sweetie

### **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- All classes will be run under the Mounted Games Rulebook 2026
- Hats must be tagged with pink hat tags and not have a fixed peak
- No jewellery to be worn. Long hair tied up and secured in a hairnet
- Lead reins to be attached to ponies' nosebands
- Ponies not to be left unattended or tied to a trailer/horsebox unless supervised by a responsible person
- The Pony Club Vaccination Policy 2026 will be used and passports checked
- Competitors should report to the Tack Check Steward at least 30 minutes before the start of the parade

### **REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT:**
