They will need the same riding kit as for Junior Camp:

Jods, polo shirt, sweat shirt, riding hat, back protector & wet weather gear

A white shirt, pc tie, clean jods & tweed jacket for the last day.

(Dark coloured jodhpurs are fine but one pair of light coloured jodhpurs are needed for the last day)

We will provide lunch & afternoon tea, please bring:

1 Dinner Plate

1 Tea Plate

1 Pudding bowl

1 Mug or beaker

1 knife, fork & spoon

Each item must be unbreakable & clearly named.

They will each have their own stable to use during the day, this will need skipping out & left clean ready for the following day.

Please bring the following for your pony:

Small skip/mucking out kit

Grooming kit

Tack cleaning kit

1 water bucket

Hay & haynet, either bring in daily or a supply for the week with a tarp to cover.

Saddle, bridle, head collar and rope, a rug if used.

We will finish around 4.00pm on Friday 4th. Parents and friends are invited to come in after 1.30pm on the last day to watch the competition and **then help clear up.**

Please return the following **to Joy at least 2 weeks before camp** –

- **Flu Vaccination Certificate** – A copy of an up-to-date flu vaccination certificate (both the front, showing horse/pony's name, and the certificate itself) Booster to be within 12 months.
- **Medical Disclaimer Form** - your signed disclaimer, which is included with this email

We require this information prior to camp to ensure that we know of any medical conditions & specific food allergies or dietary needs

Please mark EVERYTHING clearly with your full name

Daily – Each Member is marked for Tack, Turnout and their Stable

We have a Team competition which runs throughout the week, points are awarded daily & prizes are awarded on the last day to the winning Team & Individual

Top Tip: Blitz your tack, pony and riding kit BEFORE you come to camp so you are all set up to gain top marks.
